8.2.2 Member Federations may, within statutory deadlines, Team Officials for the following roles:

- (a) One (1) Team Manager;
- (b) Up to two (2) coaches per discipline;
- (c) Up to two (2) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

8.2.2 Member Federations may register up to four (4) competitors (and in case of the host Member Federation, eight (8) competitors) for each Category in each relevant discipline.

AT THE VENUE

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES

- People suffering from Covid-19, showing symptoms of a Covid-19 infection currently or within the previous 14 days, or who have had contact with persons with a corona infection or have been in a risk area declared by the MoFA of the Republic of Poland, are not allowed to participate in the competition or to enter the event area!
- The national federations are responsible for the health of athletes registered for a competition event. It is the responsibility of all team members participating in a competition event to ensure that they are fully informed and that each athlete on a team is fully aware of all procedures, particularly with regard to Covid-19 measures.
- only one (1) representative of each team may attend the technical meeting and registration (06th August 2021),
- the competition will take place without the participation of the audience, the competition organizer will try to prepare a live stream from semi-finals and finals, the link will be published on the website: <https://www.facebook.com/mocgorfestivala>
- only competitors and officials, as well as family members (guardians) of competitors have access to the gym - all persons are required to provide their personal data (name and surname and contact telephone number) – form is attached below,
- all persons staying at the gym are required to cover their mouth and nose FFP2 masks are recommended (does not apply to athletes during the warm-up and start in the competition),
- drinking and eating indoors is allowed only in designated places,

AT THE VENUE

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES

- hand sanitizers will be available at the gym – it's strongly recommended to maintain hygiene standards at a high level. Disinfecting your hands when entering and leaving the sports facilities is obligatory. Please wash your hands with soap or disinfectant when visiting the toilets.
- liquid chalk is recommended to use,
- it is recommended to keep a social distance - 1.5 meters between individuals, group formations and gatherings of people should generally be avoided. This minimum distance must also be observed when exercising sport. It is only permitted for volunteers, assistants, officials and medical staff to fall below the minimum distance in any emergency or for safety reasons,
- please avoid habitual rituals – greeting, hugging, shaking hands and similar rituals are to be avoided,
- own equipment – each person has to use only their own equipment (chalk bag, climbing shoes, water bottle, MNP, etc.),

COVID-19 TESTS

Competitors as well as team officials will be asked to prove a negative COVID-19 test result:

- RT-PCR test that is valid for 72 hours,
- Rapid Antigen test that is valid for 48 hours,

Both types of tests will be accepted. Full Vaccination (14 days after last dose) certificates will also be accepted.

ABOUT KRAKÓW

Kraków is a city with county rights, located in southern Poland on the Vistula river, as the second largest city in Poland both with regard to the population and surface area. It is a former capital of Poland, Royal Capital City and necropolis of Polish kings, as well as the capital of Małopolska Region.

The city is located at a meeting point of several geographic regions: Sandomierz Basin, West-Beskidian Piedmont and Polish Jurassic Highland.

The history of Kraków as an organised urban centre begins around the 7th and 8th centuries Anno Domini. To this day, we can admire the remains left behind the initial settlers in the form of two mounds: Krakus and Wanda. Another crucial date in the history of the city was its reception of city rights modelled on the Magdeburg Law on the 5th June 1257, allowing the formation of the current shape of the Old Town. As a result, the Wawel Castle became the seat of the contemporary ruler of Poland. The city's location at an intersection of trade routes: from Rus' to Germany and the Kingdom of Bohemia (today's Czech Republic), and from Pomerania to Hungary, Turkey and the Balkans, allowed its fast economic growth.

ABOUT KRAKÓW

The capital city of Poland was at the peak of its development in the Polish Golden Age (16th century). In those times, Kraków was – as it is now – the city of science and culture. It attracted the greatest artists, whose works can still be seen today: The altarpiece by Veit Stoss or the cloister at the Wawel Castle, designed by Bartolommeo Berrecci. The history of Kraków is inextricably linked to the history of the Polish nation.

After the Golden Age, the power of the res publica came to a close. The Swedish Deluge, economic downfall and partitions of Poland took their toll on the fate of the country and the city. However, its residents never forgot the times of Kraków's greatness. Perhaps this is why the city was always a real patriotic lair of the nation. This is whence the First Cadre Company marched, led by Józef Piłsudski, which is why this is also where the invader's army was disarmed on the Independence Day.

Today, Kraków is a modern and developing city and a melting pot where tradition of indigenous residents is mixed with student's avant-garde. However, thanks to a great number of monuments, excellently preserved in the city's layout, it has never lost its majestic character. Krakow is simply magical.
