### Deadline

The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **7 October 2021 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.**

### Registration fees

Euro 25€ for each competitor per discipline.

The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations. No cash-payments will be done on site

## COMPETITION UNDER COVID19

During the registration (on 22<sup>nd</sup> of October for the lead competition and on 23<sup>rd</sup> of October for the speed competition) all team members will have to present mandatory:

- **A certificate of vaccination**
  - Since more than 14 days after administration of a second dose of Pfizer/BioNTech or Moderna or AstraZeneca or Janssen
  - Since more than 28 days after administration of a dose of Janssen
- **Or a negative PCR or antigenic test**
  - From less than 48 hours before the date of the registration
- **Or a proof of recovery**
  - 11 days after your recovery (and subsequent negative test result) and less than six months

The competition will be held under the regulation of the IFSC Addendum ([https://cdn.ifsc-climbing.org/images/World\\_Competitions/210705\\_Addendum\\_COVID-19\\_v18.pdf](https://cdn.ifsc-climbing.org/images/World_Competitions/210705_Addendum_COVID-19_v18.pdf))

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country.

The FFME and the IFSC Europe will not be responsible for any of these costs.

#### Ropes

For the lead competition, athletes (or teams) have to bring their own ropes (clearly tagged with the name of the athlete or the national team).
