Pre-registration: In order to support the efficient organisation of the competitions, it is very important that National Federations register participants to the competitions as early as possible.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **21 April 2022 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.**

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country.

The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

10. TRAVEL INFORMATION (as of 23rd March 2022)

BEFORE TRAVELLING

1. Passengers must use the Advance Input System for Quarantine Information to proceed with the advance input before the entry.
Please visit [Here](#) to input your information.
2. PCR negative certificate within 48 hours (result to be insert in the system [Here](#))
 - The testing must have been performed, and a certificate must have been issued, within 48 hours before the departure date.
 - The tests must be based on DNA amplification(RT-PCR, LAMP, TMA, SDA, NEAR, etc)
 - Required items: Name, Date of birth, Test method, Test date, Test result, Date of Issuance, and name of testing centre should be included in the rest result.
 - The test result must be NEGATIVE
 - The test method must be written in Korean or English.
3. Proof of completed vaccination must be registered through 'Q-code system' before departure and scan QR code upon arrival.
 - Those who received the second(1st for Janseen) shot of WHO Covid-19 vaccine for emergency use within 14 to 180 days or the 3rd(booster shot)
 - WHO Covid-19 vaccine for emergency use: Pfizer, Janssen, Moderna, AZ, Covishield, Snopham, Sinovex, Covaxin, Novavax, Covishield(as of Mar. 21, 2022)

UPON ARRIVAL

When entering Korea, entrants should take a PCR test within 24 hours and you can freely move if the Test result is negative.

DURING THE EVENT

RESPONSE PROTOCOL IN CASE OF POSITIVE TEST OR SUSPECTED CASE OF COVID-19

1.1. RESPONSE PROTOCOL IN CASE OF (SUPPOSED) POSITIVITY

The Information Sheet shall contain the protocol to follow in case a person feels unwell and/or shows symptoms of an acute respiratory infection during the event:

- The relevant Team Manager or the athletes shall inform by phone the Technical Delegate (TD);
- TD will coordinate with EO and Emergency COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor on how to treat the case (treatment will depend from country to country);
- Emergency COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor shall decide what to do with the other members of the team;
- The information will be published on the virtual Official Board, without the name of the person, but only the nationality.

1.2. DECISION PROCESS IN CASE OF (SUPPOSED) POSITIVITY

In case a person feels unwell and/or shows symptoms of an acute respiratory infection during the event, after having applied the protocol sub 1.3:

- TD will organize an online meeting with IFSC President, IFSC General Director, Sport Director, Jury President, Event Organiser and Emergency COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor in order to decide if the competition shall be suspended, postponed, or cancelled;
- IFSC President has the final decision about the competition; in case IFSC President, for any

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reason, is not reachable, the final decision will be taken by IFSC General Director;

- TD will inform all the participants and Team Managers about the final decision and this decision will be immediately published on the Official Board and on the website.
- The management of close contact of a tested positive case will depend on the host country healthcare system and local regulations.

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
