A lost accreditation card is a potential security risk and will be treated very seriously by the security authorities. HOW TO GET TO MUNICH

ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES

All accredited teams, the IFSC family and officials who book accommodation through the Munich 2022 LOC and adhere to the booking deadlines will be provided with transfers to and from Munich Airport (MUC). You have received a link to our EMS to enter your Arrivals & Departures details. The Arrival & Departure portal as part of the EMS is now open. The travel details deadline is 27 July 2022.

BY PLANE

Munich Franz-Josef Strauss Airport is located 32 kilometres (30-minute drive) from Königsplatz. You will be provided with shuttles from the airport to the hotels.

BY TRAIN

Munich main train station is located about 800 metres (10-minute walk) from Königsplatz. Therefore, no shuttle is provided to team hotels.

PUBLIC TRANSFER

All accredited teams, IFSC Family and umpires will have public transfer included in their accreditation.

As the team hotels are near the competition venue and it is just one stop by underground there will be no additional shuttle from the team hotels to Königsplatz.


CANCELLATION POLICY FOR TEAMS







The athletes will get a guided transfer from isolation zone to call zone, where they can hand over their belongings again to the volunteers present. They will bring the athletes belongings to the Athlete's Lounge as well.

HEALTHCARE SYSTEM INFORMATION

COVID-19 REGULATIONS

Thankfully, since our last communication earlier in the year, the overall situation regarding Covid-19 in Germany has improved significantly with many relaxations on the part of the local authorities and law makers. In particular, many restrictions were dropped in Germany with effect from 1 April, so we have also reconsidered and adjusted our planned measures.

Importantly, the 2G/3G regulation previously communicated to you in February 2022 will no longer be maintained, so there will be no control of vaccination or recovered status on the part of European Championships Munich 2022. For the currently valid entry regulations to Germany, please refer to the latest info on the Federal Ministry of Health website.

Nevertheless, to ensure a safe event for all persons involved, we make the following recommendations to every accredited participant of the event.

- ▶ A minimum distance of 1.50 metres should be maintained wherever possible.
- ▶ Hygiene measures should be always observed. These include frequent and thorough hand washing and coughing and sneezing into the crook of the arm or into a paper handkerchief.
- ▶ Especially indoors or when a distance of 1.50 metres from others cannot be maintained, medical mouth-nose protection or an FFP2 mask must be worn. Masks will be kept ready and provided at entrances.
- ▶ Persons wishing to undergo voluntary rapid antigen testing (PoC) will be provided with testing stations at selected locations to be communicated later.
- ▶ Persons with a confirmed SARS Cov-2 infection will not be allowed access to the sports venues and will be required to go into isolation.

Rest assured, should there be any changes in the legal situation or a different assessment of the situation in the coming weeks, we will inform you immediately and adapt promptly to the guidelines and measures.

STUDY EC2022


The Study is about Injuries and Illnesses while and just before a multisport event. In context of the European Championships the study team will collect anonymous data about injuries and illnesses during training, warm-up and competition.

Therefore, a study team will be present at the medical centre of all official venues and will document the injuries and illnesses. The aim of the study is a better care for athletes during multisport events. It is important to ensure better planning for athletes and organizers with a scientific foundation.

TEAM TICKETS

OVERALL REGULATIONS

In the spirit of the multi-sport event, accredited athletes will have the opportunity to attend events of all nine sports free of charge. Please note that the number of available seats depends on the capacity and occupancy of the venues.

HANDLING

Reservations are generally not possible, and access will be granted on site and is subject to availability. In general, no tickets will be issued. On site, the athlete can enter the venue through a specially assigned entrance (usually located at the main entrance). Admission will be granted upon presentation of a valid European Championships Munich 2022 accreditation.

There is no pre-determined entitlement to a seat. As soon as the ticket holder claims their seat, the athlete must give up the seat and find an alternative available seat. In most venues there will be a designated area for athletes.

The current ticket sales status is viewable in the European Championships 2022 web shop. By clicking on the corresponding session, the current availability can be checked. In general, a distinction is made as follows:

Available (High probability of access to the respective event).

Limited Availability (The probability of access to the event is limited and cannot be guaranteed on site).

Not available (access to the respective event is not possible).

Ticket availability is fluid and can change at short notice, therefore access is not guaranteed.

To allow other athletes access to the venue, it is important to again use the exclusive entrance when leaving the venue. This will ensure that the ticketing volunteer frees up a space in the system and another athlete can visit the event.

SUSTAINABILITY

GENERAL INFORMATION

As the LOC, we are aware of our responsibility towards nature, society and the economy and are committed to actively contribute to local and global sustainability.
