BY PLANE:

- Airport Graz: Distance to competition venue: approx. 130 km.
- Airport Ljubljana: Distance to competition venue: approx. 70km.
- <u>Airport Vienna</u> Distance to competition venue: approx. 320 km. The Vienna airport is an international airport with daily connections to all bigger cities in Europe.

BY TRAIN:

TEAM QUOTAS & RULES

LICENSES:

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Member Federations may register, within statutory deadlines, team officials for one of the following roles: (a) One (1) Head of Delegation.

(b) Up to two (2) coaches per discipline.

(c) Up to two (2) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

(IFSC EUROPE RULES 4.2.2)

Member Federations may register up to four (4) competitors; and in case of the host Member Federation, eight (8) competitors; for each Category in each relevant discipline. (IFSC EUROPE RULES 4.2.3)

INFORMATION REGARDING COVID-19 MEASURES:

The following rules will apply for the EC Boulder in Klagenfurt (subject to change):

Event Restrictions (as of May 17, 2022):

- Masks need to be worn indoors (except when climbing)
- In case of symptoms of a respiratory illness, people need to stay away from the event, unless they tested negative for Covid-19.
