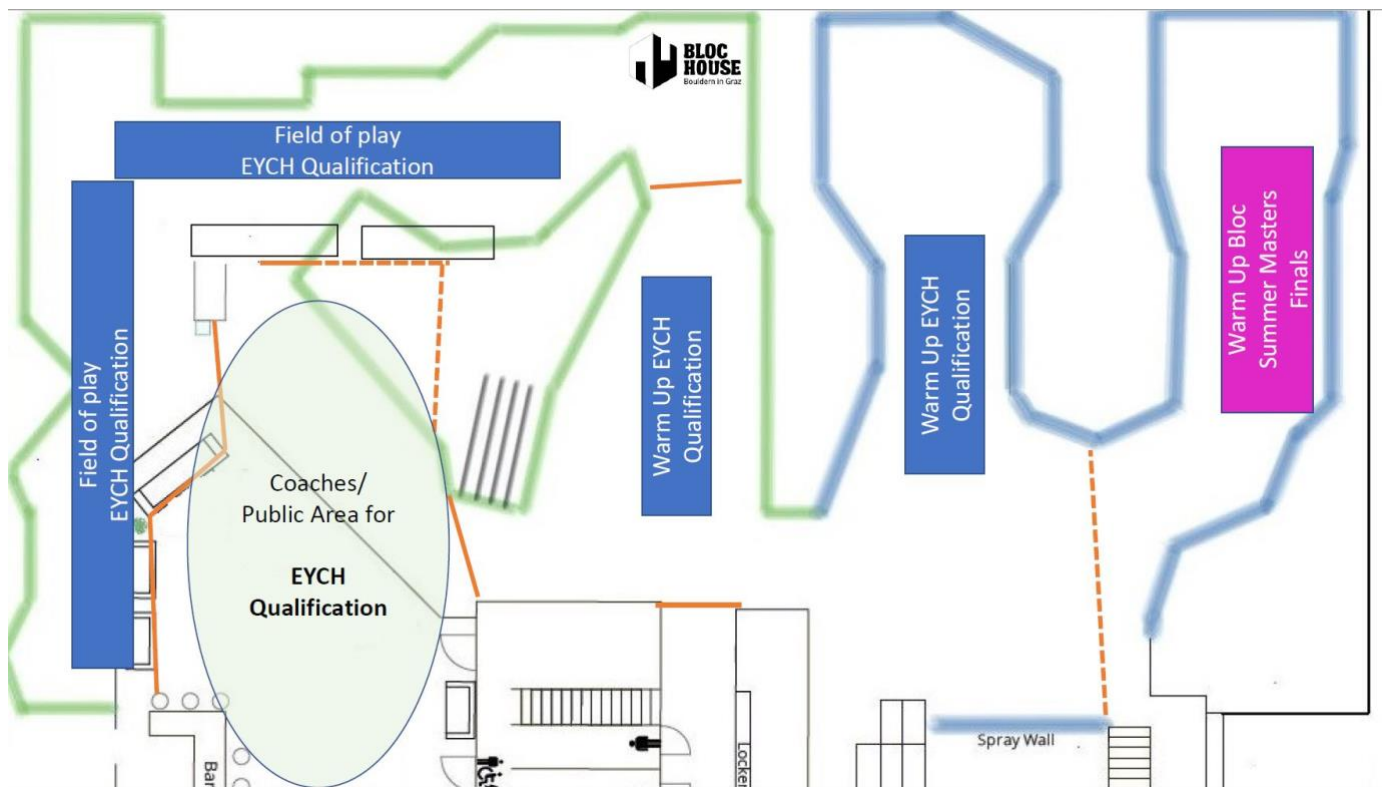

By car:

Graz is located off highway A2 and A9 and easy to get to: about 2 hours from Vienna, 4 ½ hours from Munich (GER) and 3 hours from Udine (ITA).

PARKING:

There is Parking for registered Athletes and Coaches directly at the Venue.
For Spectators we suggest using public Transport.

TEAM QUOTAS & RULES

LICENSES:

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

REGISTRATION OF TEAM OFFICIALS: (IFSC EUROPE RULES 3.2.2)

7.2.2 Member Federations may register, within statutory deadlines, team officials for one of the following roles:

- One (1) Head of Delegation
- Up to three (3) coaches per discipline;
- Up to three (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

REGISTRATION OF COMPETITORS: (IFSC EUROPE RULES 3.2.3)

Member Federations may register as competitors:

- up to three (3) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline; and

Euro 40,- for each competitor. The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations. No cash-payments will be done on site.

For the registration on Wednesday, 3rd of August it is necessary for all team managers to show the passports or ID-cards of their competitors.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The EYCH Boulder will be organised in Flash Mode (see IFSC Europe Rules) in Qualification. Semifinals and Finals are organised in IFSC-WC Semifinal Mode with a quota of twenty (20) and eight (8) competitors respectively and on a course of four (4) boulders.

All rounds will be organised as a series of attempt rotations for each boulder including:

- Preparation of 15 seconds
- Climbing period of 4 minutes
- NO extra observation time

ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS

By participating, the athlete agrees to comply with the currently valid anti-doping rules and regulations of Wada, IFSC and IFSC-Europe (in particular statutes, competition rules, anti-doping regulations).

All persons who are licensees of the IFSC or IFSC-Europe are considered as athletes and team officials.

Furthermore, the Austrian Anti-Doping Federal Act 2021 (ADBG 2021) applies to international sports events in Austria.

COVID-19 MEASURES AND PROCEDURE:

Event Restrictions (as of July 25, 2022):

- Masks are mandatory indoors, except while climbing / exercising.
Further, masks are also recommended outdoors whenever social distancing is not possible.
- In case of symptoms of a respiratory illness, people need to stay away from the event, unless they tested negative for Covid-19.
- Foreseeably, no further restrictions will be necessary.

No restrictions are in place for entering Austria as a tourist.
