Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Pre-registration: In order to support the efficient organisation of the competitions, it is very important that National Federations register participants to the competitions as early as possible.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **25 August 2022 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.**

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country.

How to get to Edinburgh

By Plane:

The nearest airport is Edinburgh (6.5 miles) - taxis are available from the airport to the EICA.

By Train:

For those travelling by train, the nearest main railway station is Edinburgh Waverley (12 miles). From Edinburgh Waverley take a train to Edinburgh Park (8 miles) and taxis are available to EICA.

By Car:

EICA: Ratho is on the west side of Edinburgh, just beyond the Newbridge junction of the M8 and M9, five miles beyond Edinburgh Airport. Situated on the B7030, which joins the A71 (Edinburgh to Livingston) with the A89, (which passes Newbridge) - the entrance driveway is marked with a big orange pillar at the end of the road. Please follow our directions as some sat navs and GPS devices do not take you to the correct place when inserting the postcode.

RESPONSE PROTOCOL IN CASE OF POSITIVE TEST OR SUSPECTED CASE OF COVID-19

If I am feeling ill

If you have a cough or a temperature, stay at the hotel, avoid contact with others and call the COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor.

You should take a test as quickly as possible.

If you have symptoms of a respiratory infection or have a fever and don't feel well enough to go to work or carry out normal activities, [stay at home](#) and avoid contact with others. This replaces the previous self-isolation guidance.

If you have a cough and/or a temperature, and you have difficulty breathing and/or you are feeling faint, dial 999 and ask for an ambulance.

If I have the virus

If you have symptoms of a respiratory infection or have a fever and don't feel well enough to go to work or carry out normal activities, [stay at home](#) and avoid contact with others. This replaces the previous self-isolation guidance.

If I have been notified that I am a contact case

If you have symptoms of a respiratory infection or have a fever and don't feel well enough to go to work or carry out normal activities, [stay at home](#) and avoid contact with others. This replaces the previous self-isolation guidance.

In any case (symptoms or positive test) the team manager has to inform immediately the COVID-19 Outbreak Response Coordinator Doctor and the Technical Delegate.

The person suspected must be immediately placed in a separate room and kept away from the event.
