3. REGISTRATION

Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

IFSC Online Registration System: <https://ifsc.results.info/users/login>.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the “Registration Date”) on **4 May 2023 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**.

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

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4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

5. CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDANCE

Confirmation of Attendance

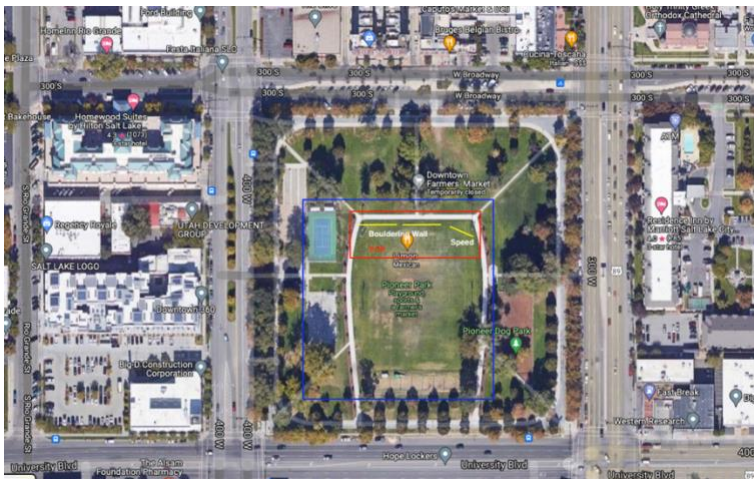

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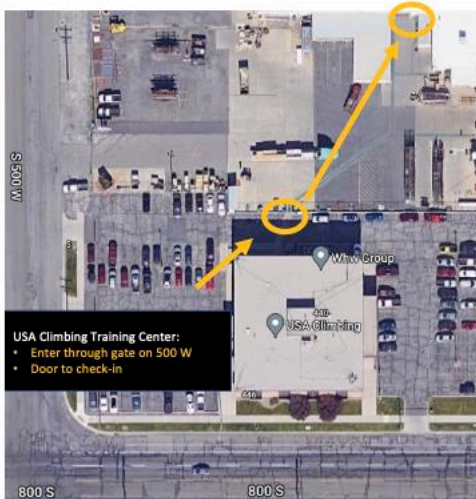
8. TECHNICAL MEETING & CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDANCE

The participation of athletes/team officials registered for both Boulder and Speed disciplines must be confirmed by the in-person attendance of either a team official (or if no team official is registered, an athlete representative of the team) at the [USA Climbing National Team Training Center] in the time slot indicated on the Provisional Programme for the event.

15. PRIZE MONEY

The top 8 athletes in each discipline and gender are awarded prize money for their performance. Immediately following the conclusion of finals, athletes eligible for prize money shall visit the prize money station located in the relative transit zones for Boulder and Speed to complete the necessary paperwork. Prize money will be paid to athletes via wire transfer, so athletes should be prepared to provide their wire transfer details.





16. HOW TO GET TO SALT LAKE CITY - TRAVEL INFORMATION

By Plane

As of January 5th, 2023: **ALL travellers 2 years and older flying to the U.S. from China, Hong Kong, or Macau, or have been in these areas in the past 10 days, and are flying from one of these airports: Incheon International Airport in Seoul, Republic of Korea, Toronto Pearson International Airport in Canada, or Vancouver International Airport in Canada** are required to show a negative COVID-19 test result taken no more than 2 days before travel. **There is also an option for people who have documented recovery from COVID-19 in the past 90 days.**

Noncitizens who are nonimmigrants and seeking to enter the United States by air are **required to show proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19** before boarding a flight to the United States from a foreign country.

If you are not fully vaccinated against COVID-19, you will **NOT** be allowed to board a flight to the United States, unless you meet the criteria for an [exception](#) under the Proclamation and CDC's Amended Order. **A booster dose is not needed to meet this requirement.**

To be considered "fully-vaccinated" you must meet one of the following:

1. 14 days after your dose of an [accepted single-dose vaccine](#)
2. 14 days after your second dose of an [accepted 2-dose vaccine](#)
3. 14 days after you receive the full series of COVID-19 vaccine in a clinical trial
4. 14 days after you received 2 doses of any "mix-and-match" combinations of [accepted COVID-19 vaccines](#) administered at least 17 days apart.

****If you do not meet one of the above, then, you will not be allowed entry into the U.S.***

*You can use the [CDC Travel Assessment](#) to learn what requirements you need to board a flight to the U.S.

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All air passengers to the United States are required to [provide contact information](#) to airlines before boarding flights to the United States.

VISAs

Consular Processing Update

- **Current Status:** Visa processing and appointment scheduling can still be a challenge in many locations, although improvement is being seen each month and in some places things are back to normal. However, it is crucial that any applicants needing visas **apply as early as they can, ideally 90-120 days in advance**. This will provide plenty of time to work through any potential issues.
- Applicants who cannot at first schedule an appointment in time for travel should request expedited appointments as needed. To do this, applicants must first schedule the earliest available regular appointment (even if beyond the date of travel), and then can re-enter the scheduling system and select the "Request Expedite" option. When requesting the expedite, the applicant should clearly explain in their message who they are and their reason for travel.

BEFORE ARRIVING:

1. Ensure passport, visas or ESTAs are current.
2. Take a COVID-19 test no more than 2 days of travel IF you are traveling **from China, Hong Kong, or Macau, or have been in these areas in the past 10 days, and are flying from one of these airports: Incheon International Airport in Seoul, Republic of Korea, Toronto Pearson International Airport in Canada, or Vancouver International Airport in Canada.**
3. For other foreign travelers, ensure you meet the criteria for being fully-vaccinated as described above or qualify for one of the exceptions.
