## 3. REGISTRATION

Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **30 May 2023 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**.

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

## 4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

- **Training opportunities for teams at Kletterzentrum Innsbruck:**  
There will be a time slot each day between May 27 and June 25 from 12:00 - 15:00 (with the exception of June 12 & 17) when Austria Climbing will open up the national team training areas of the gym (lead indoor steep part & boulder upstairs | rondell on some days) for all teams and athletes. Further, the national team training areas can be used by all teams and athletes after 18:00 each day, whenever the gym is not closed in the evening (see table above).  
The national training area „rondell“ is mostly blocked during the World Cup (June 12-18) because it is used a part of the warm-up area (see table above). Otherwise the above mentioned opening for the public applies.
- After paying the regular KI entrance fee, during these hours, all teams and athletes will have the possibility to use the national team training areas. Please notice that you will not be granted exclusive use and that changes can also occur on short notice.

- There will be **no parking possibilities** at Kletterzentrum Innsbruck before, during, and shortly after the event. Further information regarding parking in Innsbruck, public transport and how to get around in Innsbruck will follow here or on our website.
