Following the Registration Date and until the **3rd of August 2023 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor

7. HOW TO GET TO SEOUL

The distance from Incheon International Airport to the Venue: 70Km

By Airport Limousine from Incheon Intl Airport

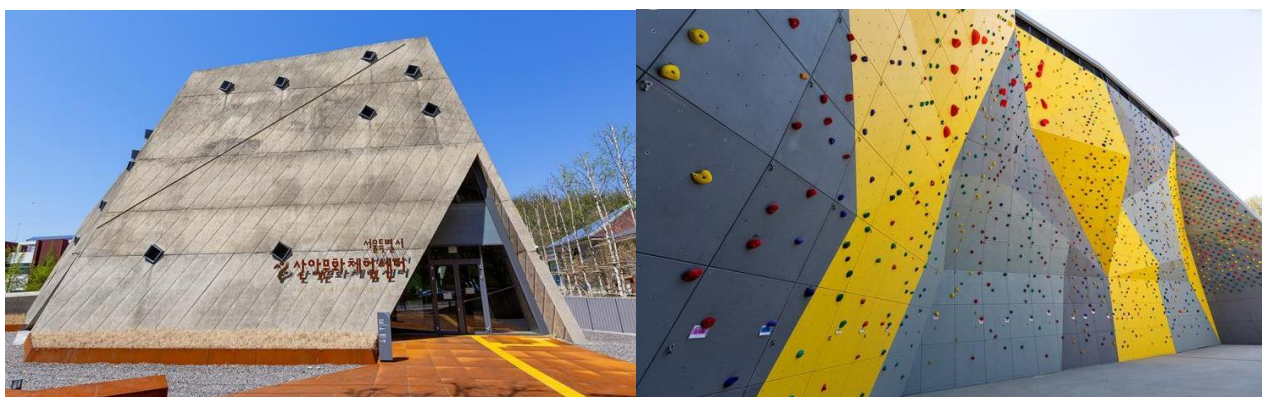
