The EC is organized by the IFSC Europe in accordance with the IFSC general and boulder regulations:

LICENSES:

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

TEAM OFFICIALS AND COMPETITORS:

Member federations may register, within statutory deadlines, all their team officials who shall be granted free entry into the competition venue.

These officials shall be registered via the <u>organization website</u>, must be in possession of a valid international license and specifically nominated for one of the following roles:

- One (1) team manager
- Up to two (2) team coaches
- Up to two (2) medical or paramedical personnel

Registration fees: 25€ for each competitor. The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations.

No cash-payments will be done on site


Only competitors who are or will be at least 16 years of age in the year of the competition shall be eligible to compete.

Member federations may register as competitors:

- Up to four (4) competitors per gender in each discipline
- The host federation shall be entitled to register an additional 4 (four) competitors per gender in each relevant discipline
- Up to two (2) competitors per gender in each relevant discipline for the African council

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The competition takes place in a green environment at the foot of the Picos de Europa. The Picos de Europa are an entrance to one of the most emblematic mountains of the country, so the control of garbage, pollution and space will be essential.

Transport:

The travel company will be responsible for grouping competitors and technicians in buses and vehicles to avoid the overcrowding of cars on site. Attempts will be made to ensure that these vehicles are labelled with low pollution.

You can also rent electric cars in the multiple options provided at airports. All companies have environmentally efficient car options at the multiple airports nearby. For example:
