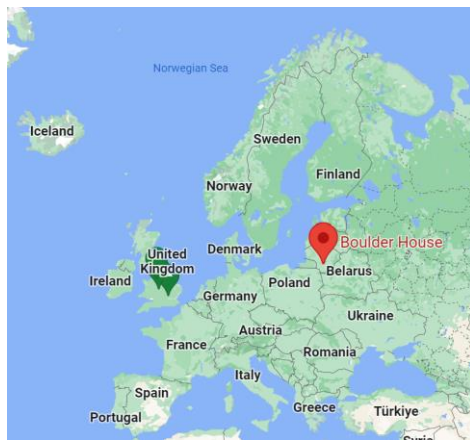
The EYC BOULDER is allocated by the IFSC Europe in accordance with the IFSC general and discipline regulations and the European Youth Cup rules.

TEAM QUOTAS & RULES:

LICENSES:

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

REGISTRATION OF TEAM OFFICIALS & COMPETITORS (IFSC EUROPE RULES 2.2.2)

Member Federations may register, within statutory deadlines, team officials for one of the following roles:

- One (1) Head of Delegation.
- Up to three (3) coaches per discipline.
- Up to three (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

TEAM QUOTA: (IFSC EUROPE RULES 2.2.3)

Member Federations may register as competitors:

- a. Per Category U16 and U18
 - up to three (3) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline
 - up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC-Europe Rules Art. 2.3)
- b. Per Category U20
 - up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline
 - up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC-E rules Art. 2.3)
- c. the host federation shall be entitled to register an additional two (2) competitors in each Category for each relevant discipline.
- d. up to two (2) competitors for each Category and gender in each relevant discipline for the African council

AGE CATEGORIES:

U20: 2004 – 2005

U18: 2006 – 2007

U16: 2008 – 2009

COMPETITION FORMAT:

The format for qualifications has been changed by the IFSC Europe Executive Board.

Qualifications: 6 (3+3)Boulders/4 Minutes (preparation time 15 seconds); Flash-Mode (All boulders will be presented to the athletes by video)

Finals: 4 Boulders/4minutes (preparation time 15 seconds); Quota: 10/category

REGISTRATION FEES:

Euro 25,- for each competitor. The Registration fee will be invoiced by IFSC Europe to the National Federations. No cash-payments will be done on site.

For the registration on site, it is necessary for all team managers to show the passports or ID-cards (or electronic copies / photos) of their competitors.

ANTI - DOPING REGULATIONS:

By participating, the athlete agrees to comply with the currently valid anti-doping rules and regulations of WADA, IFSC and IFSC Europe and Lithuanian Anti Doping Agency (statutes, competition rules and anti-doping regulations in particular).

SUSTAINABILITY

No temporary infrastructure needs to be built in order to host the EYC Kaunas 2023. Only existing walls and buildings will be used to facilitate the event.

Transport and accomodation:

- As most of the hotels are in the city center (around 6 km away from the venue) note that to reach the gym you can use public transport (buses, trolley buses or electric Bolt

scooters). There are some hostels close to the venue, they can be found via Booking or Airbnb platforms.

- Note that Kaunas is accessible by train, before booking a means of travel check if this could be a suitable option for your team to reach Lithuania.

At the venue: Note that in Lithuania tap water is safe to drink so bring your own bottles for water refill.
