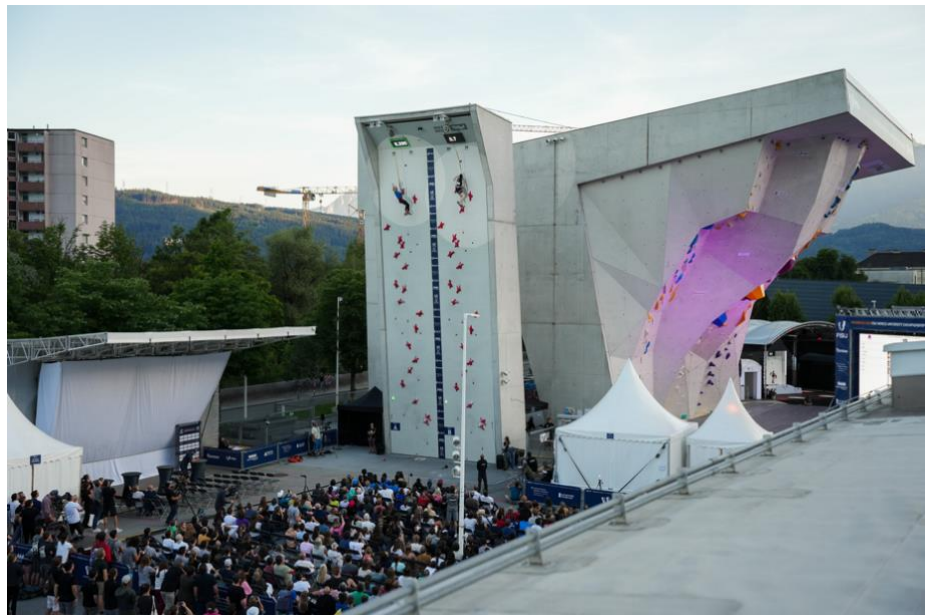

REGISTRATION

Registration & Quota (IFSC-E Rules 4.2.)

4.2.1 Each EC competition shall include Categories for male and female competitors. Only competitors who are or will be at least 16 years of age in the year of the competition shall be eligible to compete.

4.2.2 Member Federations may register, within statutory deadlines, Team Officials for one of the following roles:

- (a) one (1) Team Manager
- (b) up to two (2) coaches per discipline
- (c) up to two (2) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

4.2.3 Member Federations may register as competitors:

- (a) up to four (4) competitors per gender in each relevant discipline
- (b) the host federation shall be entitled to register an additional four (4) competitors per gender in each relevant discipline
- (c) up to two (2) competitors per gender in each relevant discipline for the African council

Registration Deadline: 10 days prior to the first day of the event: **02 June 2023 at 11:59 pm CET**

Registration Fees: 25€, for each competitor, for each competition. The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations. on-site Registration for the Confirmation of Attendance will be present into the competition venue. No cash-payments will be done on site.

Confirmation of attendance: Physical confirmation of registration is mandatory. The Team Manager is responsible to communicate the presence of the National Team. The schedule and location of the conformation of attendance is outlined in the program of the event.

2 rounds (Qualification and Finals) will take place, as long as number of registered competitors is four (4) or more.

Final Quotas:

Number of Finalists	Number of valid times in Q
16	16 or more
8	8 - 15
4	4 - 7

If in any Category, less than four (4) competitors have at least one valid time from the qualification round, the relevant qualification round shall be repeated (once only). If, following this repeated qualification less than four (4) competitors have at least one valid time, no final shall be held for that Category.

ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS

By participating, the athlete agrees to comply with the currently valid anti-doping rules and regulations of WADA, IFSC and IFSC Europe (statutes, competition rules and anti-doping regulations in particular). All persons who are licensees of the IFSC or IFSC Europe are considered as athletes and team officials. Furthermore, the Austrian Anti-Doping Federal Act 2021 (ADBG 2021) applies to international sports events in Austria.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

Venue

In order to prepare for the whole IFSC Climbing World Cup (taking place 12 – 18 June in Innsbruck), several temporary structures and technical equipment need to be built up. However, these temporary facilities are well used for 3 World Cups & 1 European Cup within 7 days. For a big part of the event, existing infrastructure will be used (e.g. Kletterzentrum Innsbruck for warm up).

Transport in Innsbruck:

The city of Innsbruck has a well-functioning network of public transportation and several opportunities to rent bikes and e-scooters. All necessary information can be found here:
