TRAVEL DETAILS

How to get there:

- Air: Airport Zürich-Kloten and Geneva-Cointrin: railway station in the airport of Geneva and Zürich and trains to Berne every half an hour. To continue to Niederwangen, there are trains which leave the railway station of Berne in the direction of Niederwangen every half an hour.
- Train: Berne-main station, regional train (direction Fribourg Lausanne) every 30 minutes.
 10 minutes to walk to the climbing centre MAGNET.
- Car: Coming from Zürich or Geneva, Exit Bern-Niederwangen. Enough (150) parking places for free direct by the climbing centre. IMPORTANT: <u>It is not allowed to stay or to camp over</u> <u>night</u>. Please respect this.

TEAM QUOTAS AND RULES

The EYC is organized by the IFSC Europe in accordance with the IFSC general and lead regulations and the European Youth Cup Lead rules:

Licenses:

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Team Officials:

Member federations may register, with statutory deadlines, all their team officials who shall be granted free entry into the competition venue.

These officials shall be registered via the IFSC website, must be in possession of a valid international licence and specially nominated for one of the following roles:

- a) One (1) team manager
- b) Up to tree (3) team coaches
- c) Up to tree (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnels

Competitors and Team Quota:

- a) Per category
 - 1. U16 and U18:
 - i. Up to three (3) competitors for each category in each relevant discipline
 - ii. Up to two (2) competitors for each category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC- Europe Rules Art. 2.3)
 - 2. U20
 - i. Up to two (2) competitors for each category in each relevant discipline.









- ii. Up to two (2) competitors for each category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC- Europe Rules Art. 2.3).
- **b)** The host federation shall be entitled to register an additional two (2) competitors in each Category for each relevant discipline.
- c) Up to two (2) competitors for each Category and gender in each relevant discipline for the African council.

REGISTRATION

Registration Deadline:

The deadline for registration is 15 days before the 1st day of event: June 2, 2023 (23:59 local time (CEST)).

Registration Fees:

25€ for each competitor. In case of late registration (after reg. deadline) please send an e-mail with the relevant athletes to europe.events@ifsc-climbing.org (Alfons Dornauer, IFSC-E) Late registrations will have a fee of 95€.

The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC to the National Federations. No cash-payments will be done on site.

For the registration on Friday June 16, 2023, it is necessary for all team managers to show the passports or ID-cards of their competitors (or copy).

Registration desk:

MAGNET, Climbing Center, Main entrance (Hall 1), follow the signs "Registration".









Confirmation of attendance:

Physical confirmation of registration is mandatory. The Team Manager is responsible to communicate the presence of the National Team. The schedule and location of the conformation of attendance is outlined in the program of the event.

COMPETITION FORMAT LEAD

Two rounds – (qualification and final). Organized for each category like the qualification round in the IFSC – WC (IFSC Rule 7.1)

The final round with a fixed quota of ten (10) competitors for each category.

ANTI-DOPING REGULATION

By participating, the athlete agrees to comply with the currently valid anti-doping rules and regulation of WADA, IFSC and IFSC-Europe (statutes, competition rules, anti-doping regulation). All people who are licensees of the IFSC or IFSC-Europe are considered as athletes and team officials.

The anti-doping tests will be conducted by **Swiss Sports Integrity**.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

Venue: No temporary infrastructure needs to be built in order to host EYC Magnet-Niederwangen 2023. Only existing walls will be used to facilitate the event. In Switzerland tap water is safe to drink, so bring your own bottles for water refill.

Transport: Magnet-Niederwangen has a railway station 1.5 km from the venue.
