TRAVEL DETAILS

Arrival by car

Level24 Climbing Gym is about 20 minutes (8.8 km - via Viale Sandro Pertini) from Bologna, the capital of Emilia Romagna. The city is at the junction of the A1, A14 and A13, easily accessible from all over Italy. Most of the traffic from Milan leaves the A1 and take the ring road.

Arrival by public transports

The gym can be reached from Bologna Auto station with the line 671 till the stop Casalecchio Santa Lucia or with the regional train from the central railway station (Bologna Centrale – Vignola) till Casalecchio Ceretolo. The central railway station of Bologna is one of the main hubs of rail transport in northern Italy, with high-speed connections between the main Italian cities.

Arrival by plane

The airport of Bologna is the Guglielmo Marconi International Airport, a few minutes from the city center, served by taxi, and a special bus line called Aerobus. Ryanair flies to Bologna Guglielmo Marconi. British Airways and Turkish Airlines have 2 or 3 flights per day from/to London Heathrow and from/to Istanbul Ataturk, respectively. Marconi also has numerous international connections available, including non-stop flights to Amsterdam, Budapest, Brussels, Charleroi (Brussels South), Copenhagen, Dublin, Edinburgh, Istanbul, Katowice, Lisbon, London, Madrid, Moscow, Paris, Prague, Vienna, Warsaw (Modlin), Wroclaw and Zagreb.
