- Additionally, the national team training areas of the gym (lead indoor steep part, boulder upstairs & rondell) will be reserved by the AUT national team at certain hours a day.
- Training opportunities for teams at Kletterzentrum Innsbruck:

There will be a time slot each day between May 27 and June 25 from 12:00 - 15:00 (with the exception of June 12 & 17) when Austria Climbing will open up the national team training areas of the gym (lead indoor steep part & boulder upstairs | rondell on some days) for all teams and athletes. Further, the national team training areas can be used by all teams and athletes after 18:00 each day, whenever the gym is not closed in the evening (see table above). The national training area "rondell" is mostly blocked during the World Cup (June 12-18) because it is used a spart of the warm-up area (see table above). Otherwise the above mentioned opening
