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3. **REGISTRATION**

Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **18 April 2024 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.**

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

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Scheduling Visa Appointments:

- If an applicant is not able to schedule a visa appointment before their date of travel, they can • request an expedited appointment. To request an expedite, the applicant must first schedule a regular appointment (even if it is beyond the date of travel), and then re-enter the scheduling system and select the "Request Expedite/Emergency Appointment" option.
- When requesting an expedite, applicants must clearly explain their reason for travel and dates of • travel to the U.S.
- Applicants can also consider applying in a third-country location with shorter wait-times. There is no penalty for applying anywhere appointments are available, even outside one's home country.

Requirements to Travel to the United States for Foreign Travelers

*As of May 12, 2023, noncitizen non-immigrant air passengers will no longer need to show proof of being fully vaccinated with an accepted COVID-19 vaccine to board a flight to the United States.
