3. REGISTRATION

Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

IFSC Online Registration System: <https://ifsc.results.info/users/login>.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **11 June 2024 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**.

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

5. CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDANCE

Confirmation of Attendance

Physical confirmation of registration is mandatory. The Team Manager is responsible to communicate the presence of the National Team. The schedule and location of the confirmation of attendance is outlined in the program of the event.

7. HOW TO GET TO INNSBRUCK

By plane:

Airport Innsbruck

Distance to competition venue: approx. 5 km.

Distance to competition area: approx. 200 km.

8. TRANSPORTATION IN INNSBRUCK

There are no parking space available for teams or spectators at Kletterzentrum Innsbruck during the event. Please consider the following options of arrival to the venue:

Closest Public Transport Stops and Lines:

Several bus and tram lines stop just a few minutes' walk away:

Bus line T - bus stop "Sebastian-Scheel-Straße" (approx. 5 minutes on foot)

Bus line R - bus stop "Messe Bahnhof" (approx. 10 minutes on foot)

Tram line 1 - bus stop "Bundesbahndirektion" or "Haydnplatz" (approx. 10 minutes on foot)

Tram line 2 or tram line 5 - bus stop "Radetzkystraße" (approx. 8 minutes on foot, crossing the bridge east of the gym)

Bus line 540 - stop "Wohnheim Saggen" (approx. 3 minutes on foot)

"Messe Bahnhof" is also a railway station with local train connections (10 minutes walking)

From the main station it is a 30 minute walk to get to the venue. But there are also bus connections.
