Training: Some areas of Kletterzentrum Innsbruck will be closed or restricted in the weeks leading up to the event, due to route setting and construction work for the World Cup.

As last year, we will guarantee some time slots where training in the Training Center Areas of Kletterzentrum Innsbruck (steep part of the Lead Indoor Wall & Boulder 1st floor) is possible, after paying the usual entrance fee of Kletterzentrum Innsbruck.

From 17 June until 12 July, generally: From 12:00 - 15:00 and after 18:00 the Training Center Areas will not be reserved for Austria Climbing. However, sometimes these areas might be used as warm-up / isolation for the World Cup.

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PUBLIC TRANSPORT

One of the bus stops is currently not in use due to maintenance. Also, we have the benefit this year that with the accreditation badge all public transport in Innsbruck can be used for free. Please change the paragraph "Transportation in Innsrbuck" to the following:

There are no parking space available for teams or spectators at Kletterzentrum Innsbruck during the event. Please consider public transport for your travel tot he venue and back.

IMPORTANT: You can use your accreditation badge as a ticket for public transportation in Innsbruck from June 24 – 30. This includes all bus and tram lines within the core zone, including line 540, except "The Sightseer". Please note the imprint on your accreditation badge.

Closest Public Transport Stops and Lines:

Several bus and tram lines stop just a few minutes' walk away:

Bus line T - bus stop "Sebastian-Scheel-Straße" (approx. 5 minutes on foot)

Bus line R - bus stop "Messe Bahnhof" (approx. 10 minutes on foot)

Tram line 1 - bus stop "Bundesbahndirektion" (approx. 10 minutes on foot) Tram line 2 or tram line 5 - bus stop "Radetzskystraße" (approx. 8 minutes on foot, crossing the bridge east of the gym)

Bus line 540 - stop "Wohnheim Saggen" (approx. 3 minutes on foot)

"Messe Bahnhof" is also a railway station with local train connections (10 minutes walking) From the main station it is a 30 minute walk to get to the venue. But there are also bus connections.
