REGISTRATION

Team quota – EUROPEAN CUP (IFSC-E 2023 Rules 4.2):

Each EC competition shall include Categories for male and female competitors. Only competitors who are or will be at least 16 years of age in the year of the competition shall be eligible to compete. Member Federations may register, within statutory deadlines, Team Officials for one of the following roles:

- 1. (a) one (1) Team Manager.
- 2. (b) up to two (2) coaches per discipline.
- 3. (c) up to two (2) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.
- Member Federations may register as competitors:
- 1. (a) up to four (4) competitors per gender in each relevant discipline.
- 2. (b) the host federation shall be entitled to register an additional four (4) competitors per gender in each relevant discipline. Event Organiser's Sponsors IFSC EUROPE EVENT
- 3. (c) up to two (2) competitors per gender in each relevant discipline for the African council Team quota













EUROPEAN YOUTH CUP (IFSC-E 2023 Rules 2.2):

Each EYC competition shall include Categories for male and female competitors in the U16, U18, and U20 age groups.

Member Federations may register, within statutory deadlines, Team Officials for one of the following roles:

1. (a) One (1) Team Manager

2. (b) Up to three (3) coaches per discipline.

3. (c) Up to three (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

Member Federations may register as competitors:

1. (a) Per Category

1. (i) U16 and U18 1. (i) up to three (3) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline

2. (ii) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC- Europe Rules Art. 2.3)

2. (ii) U20

1. (i) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline

2. (ii) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC- E rules Art. 2.3)

2. (b) the host federation shall be entitled to register an additional two (2) competitors in each Category for each relevant discipline.

3. (c) up to two (2) competitors for each Category and gender in each relevant discipline for the African council

Age categories:

- Juniors (U20) 2004 2005
- Youth A (U18) 2006 2007
- Youth B (U16) 2008 2009

REGISTRATION FEES: 30 € per athlete. The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations. SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

Transport: According to the Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan of the Lublin Metropolitan Area (PZMM LOM), the city public transport system offers 58 bus and 13 trolleybus lines that provide convenient communication and transport to all urban districts and nearby locations. Public transport is mostly operated by electric and hybrid vehicles. All buses and trolleybuses are adapted to transport disabled people and equipped with passenger space monitoring, air conditioning, and internal LCD boards. In the period from spring to autumn, the city provides access to the Lublin City Bike and electric scooters rentals. All urban traffic is controlled by Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS), innovations introduced in European cities to improve traffic flow, as well as reduce noise levels and exhaust emissions. They not only provide greater comfort while using public transport or individual vehicles, but also make life in the city much safer and cheaper.

Venue: No temporary infrastructure needs to be built in order to host the ECS Lublin 2024. To facilitate the event, only existing buildings will be used. In general, SKW Kotłownia takes sustainability actions very seriously and tries to implement a "green way of thinking" in all areas of their everyday business, allowing for the organisation of events. The venue has solar heating and photovoltaic panels. Additionally, 80% of the illumination will be led lamp.

Food and drinks: There are many restaurants in the area serving Polish, Chinese and Italian cuisine. A bar with hot drinks, vegetarian and vegan dishes will be available at the venue. Water will be provided for competitors.

- Katowice Airport (KTW) 436 km

Airports are directly connected with most of the main European cities, also via low-cost airlines.
