3. REGISTRATION

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 6 weeks before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on 13 MAY 2024 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.

In case of late arrival please contact the IFSC Event Delegate as soon as possible.


Confirmation of Attendance

Physical confirmation of registration is mandatory. The Team Manager is responsible to communicate the presence of the National Team latest by the end of the classification, even if the respective athletes do not need to go to classification.

SUPPORT TEAM GUIDANCE – (Incl. use of communication electronics)

Visually impaired sight guides must use a radio headset for communication with their athletes.

Shouting (or an equivalent projected verbal communication) will be allowed in case of technical failure during climbing. Technical failures must be communicated to the IFSC Officials as soon as is practicably possible.

In finals, each visually impaired athlete must have their own dedicated sight guide which may not guide other athletes in finals.

10. HOW TO GET TO INNSBRUCK

By plane:

Airport Innsbruck

Distance to competition venue: approx. 5 km.

11. TRANSPORTATION IN INNSBRUCK

There are no parking space available for teams or spectators at Kletterzentrum Innsbruck during the event. Please consider the following options of arrival to the venue:

Public Transport:

Several bus and tram lines stop just a few minutes' walk away:

Bus line T - bus stop "Sebastian-Scheel-Straße" (approx. 5 minutes on foot)

Bus line R - bus stop "Messe Innsbruck" (approx. 10 minutes on foot)

Tram line 1 - bus stop "Bundesbahndirektion" or "Haydnplatz" (approx. 10 minutes on foot)

Tram line 2 - bus stop "Radetzskystraße" (approx. 8 minutes on foot, crossing the bridge east of the gym)

Tram line 5 - bus stop "Radetzskystraße" (approx. 8 minutes on foot, crossing the bridge east of the gym)

Bus line 540 - stop "Wohnheim Saggen" (approx. 5 minutes on foot)

From the railway station "Bahnhof Messe" you can also reach the event area in approx. 10 minutes on foot. From the main station it takes about 30 minutes.
