3. REGISTRATION

Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition. (Licence fee don't be charged to NF for athletes and officials who ONLY participate in South American cup)

IFSC Online Registration System: <https://ifsc.results.info/users/login>.

Registration Fee: Registration fee is **30 \$ (USD)** per athlete competitor per discipline. Fee will be paid by cash at Registration.

Registration. Quota: 5 participants per gender per NF + 2 under 18 + 2 extra for host NF per discipline.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **29 November 2024 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**.

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

From Afonso Pena

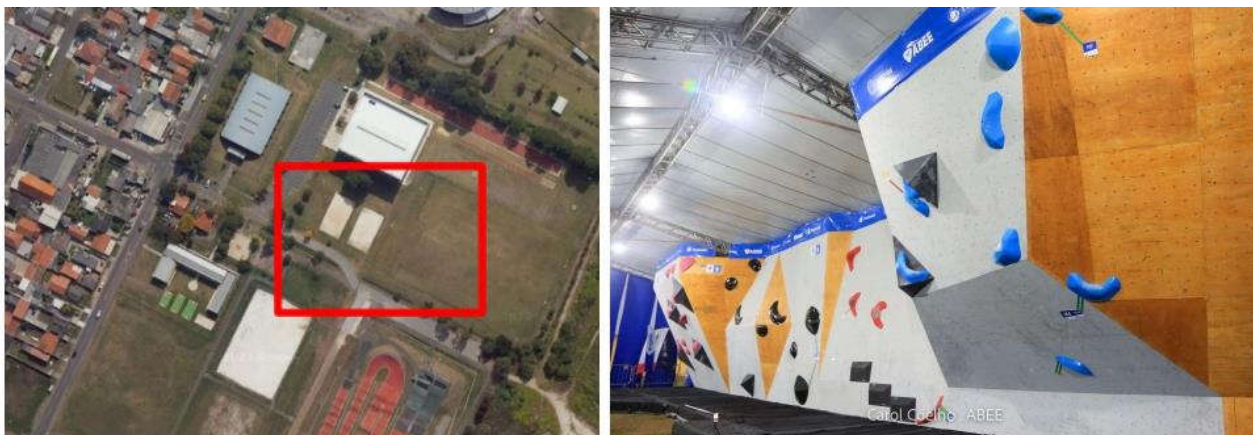
There is a wide range of options for traveling from Afonso Pena International Airport to Curitiba, including airport bus, local bus, taxis and Uber.
