## 3. REGISTRATION

**Licenses:** Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition. (Licence fee don't be charged to NF for athletes and officials who ONLY participate in South American cup)

**IFSC Online Registration System:** <https://ifsc.results.info/users/login>.

**Registration Fee:** Registration fee is **30 \$ (USD)** for each competitor. Fee will be paid by cash at Registration.

**Quota:** 5 participants per gender per NF + 2 UNDER 18 + 2 extra for host NF per discipline.

**Deadline:** The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **14 November 2023 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**. (19h Argentina time)

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

## 4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

## 5. CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDANCE

### Delayed Arrival

### Confirmation of Attendance

Physical confirmation of registration is mandatory. The Team Manager is responsible to communicate the presence of the National Team. The schedule and location of the conformation of attendance is outlined in the program of the event.

## 7. HOW TO GET TO MAR DEL PLATA



Mar del Plata is a coastal city in Buenos Aires Province, Argentina, with a population of about 600,000 people. It is a major port and beach resort, and the second most visited tourist destination in the country after Buenos Aires. Mar del Plata has 47 km of coastline with beautiful beaches, bays, cliffs, and forests. It also has a rich cultural and historical heritage, with museums, theatres, monuments, and festivals. Mar del Plata is known for its seafood cuisine, its sports activities, and its nightlife.

The most common way to get to Mar del Plata from other countries is to fly to Buenos Aires and then take another flight, bus, train, or car (it's possible directly from airport) to Mar del Plata.

### By Plane

The airport destination is the Astor Piazzolla International Airport (MDQ), located 10 minutes away from Mar del Plata city centre. The total flight time is around 1 hour from Buenos Aires city.

### By Train or Bus

The train and bus station are located at Mar del Plata city centre, the train option is inexpensive but it's sometimes hard to get tickets, the total trip time for both options is around 5 – 6 hours.

## 8. ACCOMMODATION

Being Mar del Plata a tourist city, there is a wide range of hotels, hostels, rental apartments, etc. Being the competition outside of commonly tourist dates there should be no problems to get accommodation. In any case, we are working to find alternatives and recommend places to the delegations that register in the competition.
