REGISTRATION

Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Registration Fee: Registration fee is **40 \$ (USD)** for each competitor and for each discipline in which they compete. Fee will be paid in cash at Registration or through an online payment system https://welcu.com/federacion-de-andinismo-de-chile/panamericano-santiago-2024

Registration Quota: 5 participants per gender per NF per discipline.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **3 November 2024 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.**

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

APPEAL

Will proceed as normally done at IFSC events: IFSC to send invoices upon conclusion of the event and receipt of Jury President report. As per the IFSC Fee System, the fee for rejected appeals is €150.

PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.
