10. SPEED FOUR LANES

The newly created IFSC Speed Four Lanes will be launched with the 2025 World Games in Chengdu (CHN). The event in Madrid represent the first event where the format will be used on international competitions. The detailed rules will be communicated on a later stage, the principles of the format are outlined here below:

10.1 Qualification

The qualification will be divided in two phases:

- a) Qualification seeding, where the athletes will be ranked according to the fastest time achieved. The athletes will climb on all the four lanes
- b) A portion of athletes will progress directly in finals
- c) Another portion of athletes will compete in the play-in, to give a second chance to qualify to finals

10.2 Finals

Each stage of the finals will be composed by four (4) athletes climbing at the same time. The best two (2) athletes progress to the next stage, until the finals. On the last stage of the event, four (4) athletes compete together to achieve the medals
