PUBLIC TRANSPORT	<p>There are no parking space available for teams or spectators at Kletterzentrum Innsbruck during the event or in the days / weeks leading up to the event. Please consider public transport for your travel to the venue and back.</p> <p>IMPORTANT: You can use your accreditation badge as a ticket for public transportation in Innsbruck from June 23 – 29.</p> <p>This includes all bus and tram lines within the core zone, except “The Sightseer”. Please note the imprint on your accreditation badge.</p> <p>Closest Public Transport Stops and Lines:</p> <p>Several bus and tram lines stop just a few minutes' walk away:</p> <p>Bus line T - bus stop "Sebastian-Scheel-Straße" (approx. 5 minutes on foot)</p> <p>Bus line 540 - stop "Wohnheim Saggen" (approx. 3 minutes on foot)</p> <p>Bus line R - bus stop "Messe Bahnhof" (approx. 10 minutes on foot)</p> <p>Tram line 1 - bus stop "Bundesbahndirektion" (approx. 10 minutes on foot)</p> <p>Tram line 2 or tram line 5 - bus stop "Radetzkystraße" (approx. 8 minutes on foot, crossing the bridge east of the gym)</p> <p>Further, there is a railway station within a 10 minute walk from the venue.
