

Training:

Some areas of Kletterzentrum Innsbruck will be closed or restricted in the weeks leading up to the event, due to route setting and construction work for the World Cup and for Austrian Nationals taking place only a few days before the World Cup. As last year, we guarantee some time slots where training in the National Training Center Areas of Kletterzentrum Innsbruck (steep part of the Lead Indoor Event Organiser Partners: IFSC Partners Wall & Boulder 1st floor) is possible, after paying the usual entrance fee of Kletterzentrum Innsbruck. CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDANCE

Austria Trend Hotel Congress Innsbruck

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

There are no parking space available for teams or spectators at Kletterzentrum Innsbruck during the event or in the days / weeks leading up to the event. Please consider public transport for your travel to the venue and back.

IMPORTANT: You can use your accreditation badge as a ticket for public transportation in Innsbruck from June 23 - 29.

This includes all bus and tram lines within the core zone, except "The Sightseer". Please note the imprint on your accreditation badge.

Closest Public Transport Stops and Lines:

Several bus and tram lines stop just a few minutes' walk away: Bus line T - bus stop "Sebastian-Scheel-Straße" (approx. 5 minutes on foot) Bus line 540 - stop "Wohnheim Saggen" (approx. 3 minutes on foot) Bus line R - bus stop "Messe Bahnhof" (approx. 10 minutes on foot) Tram line 1 - bus stop "Bundesbahndirektion" (approx. 10 minutes on foot) Tram line 2 or tram line 5 - bus stop "Radetzskystraße" (approx. 8 minutes on foot, crossing the bridge east of the gym)

Further, there is a railway station within a 10 minute walk from the venue. "Messe Bahnhof" has local train connections. The main station "Innsbruck Hauptbahnhof" is 30 minutes away from the venue.
