# TRAVELLING TO ST. PÖLTEN:

### By car:

St. Pölten is located on the A1 West Autobahn, making it easily accessible by car.

From Vienna or Salzburg, take the St. Pölten Süd exit.

From Krems/Waldviertel, take the S33 expressway and the St. Pölten Ost exit.

St. Pölten is approximately 1 hour from Vienna, 4 hours from Munich and 2.5 hours from Salzburg.

### By train:

St. Pölten Hauptbahnhof (main station) is an important transportation hub with regular connections to all major cities in Austria, as well as some major cities in Germany (Munich,...). There are direct train connections from Vienna, Linz, Salzburg, Graz, Innsbruck, and other cities.

For more information on train connections and schedules, please visit the ÖBB website (<u>www.oebb.at</u>). There is a direct connection from Vienna Airport to St. Pölten.

Next to the main train station is the main bus station, the best lines to take to the venue are 7 and 3 to the station "Sportzentrum NÖ".

### By plane:

The closest international airports are:

Vienna Airport (approximately 1 hour by train or car)

Salzburg Airport (approximately 2 hours by car or train)

Munich Airport (approximately 4 hours by car or train)

From these airports, there are regular train connections to St. Pölten.

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# **ANTI-DOPING REGULATIONS**

By participating, the athlete agrees to comply with the currently valid anti-doping rules and regulations of WADA, IFSC and IFSC Europe (statutes, competition rules and anti-doping regulations in particular). All persons who are licensees of the IFSC or IFSC Europe are considered as athletes and team officials. Furthermore, the Austrian Anti-Doping Federal Act 2021 (ADBG 2021) applies to international sports events in Austria.

### **VENUE**

For the EYC / EC Speed St. Pölten 2025 only existing walls and buildings will be used to facilitate the international teams. In general, the organisers take sustainability actions very seriously and try to implement a "green way of thinking" in all areas of their everyday business and also into the organisation of events. Other than the small climbing wall indoors to warm up, there is a Boulder gym "Boulderhalle Kraftwerk" about 10-15 minutes away by car.
