#### LICENSES

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

#### TEAM OFFICIALS AND COMPETITORS:

Member federations may register, within statutory deadlines, all their team officials who shall be granted free entry into the competition venue. These officials shall be registered via the <u>IFSC website</u>, must be in possession of a valid international licence and specifically nominated for one of the following roles:

a)One (1) team manager: b)Up to three (4) team coaches: c)Up to three (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

#### **TEAM QUOTA:**

U17: 3 competitors per gender and discipline + 2 competitors per gender and discipline for the TOP 10 ranked federations

U1 9: 3 competitors per gender and discipline + 2 competitors per gender and discipline for the TOP 10 ranked federations

- +2 additional competitors in each category for the host federation
- +2 competitors per category, gender and discipline for the African as well as for the Oceanian Council

Registration fees: 45 € per athlete. The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations.

The registration fee will then increase to 95€ for each competitor. The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations. No cash-payments will be done on site.

#### TRAVELLING TO SOURE

Soure is located near Coimbra and about 150km of Porto airport and 180 km of Lisbon airport. It has a railway station and some trains from Porto, Lisbon and Coimbra stop there.


#### TRAVEL DETAILS

By plane: The nearest airports are:

- Porto (157 km)
- Lisboa (177 km)

By train: From Porto or Lisbon you can catch a train to Soure Railway station, then take less than 10 minutes walk to the competition venue. It is possible to take a train from Porto or Lisbon to Coimbra and come to Soure by train or by bus.

By car: On motorway From Lisbon or Porto take A1: take the exit marked Soure. At the roundabouts take N348 to the right. After 6 km you are in centre of Soure.

Qualifications: 6 (3+3) Boulders/4 Minutes (preparation time 15 seconds): Flash Mode (All boulders will be presented to the athletes by video)

Finals: 4 Boulders/4 minutes (preparation time 15 seconds); Quota: 10/category.

















# **ACCOMMODATION**

#### Soure is a small village with few accommodations.

We made a special arrangement with Palace Hotel & SPA Termas do Bicanho (\*\*\*\*), about 14Km from the venue. The hotel will provide about 90 rooms for the EYCup. The price includes breakfast. Usually the hotel does not provide meals but, for the European Cup, the teams can book for it. It is possible to have free transportation between this hotel and the competition venue during the competition days, four times a day, in defined hours, depending of the competition final time table.

For Federations with autonomous transport, we are pleased to offer a special accommodation option this year: the <u>Dolinas Climbing</u> <u>Hotel</u>, located just 65 km (about a 48 minute drive) from Soure.

The Dolinas Climbing Hotel, the world's only hotel dedicated entirely to climbing, provides an unparalleled experience for participants. Key features include:

- Climbing Center: A 700m<sup>2</sup> indoor facility featuring bouldering walls, auto belays, and a 30-meter rope wall. The facility is equipped to host training sessions, competitions, and events.
- Accommodations: 93 rooms with options ranging from single to family suites, offering participants a comfortable stay.
- Amenities: A restaurant, lounge bar, gym, wellness area, and spaces for workshops and conferences.

#### **ENERGY/VENUE AND ACCOMODATION**

No temporary infrastructure needs to be built in order to host the EYC Soure 2025. Only existing walls and buildings will be used to facilitate the event.

100% of the illumination will be led lamp.

The routesetters will exclusively use ladders.

#### FOOD, DRINK, CATERING AND MERCHANDISING

In Portugal tap water is safe to drink so bring your own bottles for water refill.

We will choose local producers that supply only locally-bottled and locally-canned drinks.

We will use locally sourced food with menus with a seasonal emphasis.

All the providers will be from local companies,

#### TRANSPORT:

Soure have a railway station 1 km from the venue.

There will be a free bus, from the main hotel to the venue, 4 time a day.

#### **WAST AND WATER**

In Portugal tap water is safe to drink so bring your own bottles for water refill.

There will be separation containers for sorting and recycling waste: yellow for plastic, green for glass, blue for paper, and black for general waste.
