LICENSES:

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

TEAM OFFICIALS AND COMPETITORS:

Member federations may register, within statutory deadlines, all their team officials who shall be granted free entry into the competition venue.

These officials shall be registered via the IFSC website, must be in possession of a valid international licence and specifically nominated for one

of the following roles:

- b) Up to three (3) team coaches;
- c) Up to three (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.

TEAM QUOTA:

U17: 3 competitors per gender and discipline + 2 competitors per gender and discipline for the TOP 10 ranked federations

U19: 3 competitors per gender and discipline + 2 competitors per gender and discipline for the TOP 10 ranked federations

+2 additional competitors in each category for the host federation

+2 competitors per category, gender and discipline for the African as well as for the Oceanian Council

Training

The Molde Climbing centre is open for training before and under the competition, training room with Kilter 0-70degree, Moon 20-50degree, spray wall 52degree, boards and campus, and regular fitness equipment, lead and auto belay wall and low wall bouldering on 2nd floor



TRAVEL DETAILS

- **Arrival by car**

Molde Climbing centre is in the centre of Molde, Molde is a 7hour drive from Oslo, 4hour from Trondheim, and two-hour drive from Ålesund.

- **Arrival by plane**

Molde airport is 15 min. from the Climbing centre and your best airport for arrival. You can fly to Molde from Oslo and Bergen, choosing either <https://www.norwegian.no/> or <https://www.wideroe.no/en/fly-with-us/playable> . On the Sunday we will finish the finals in time for returning flight from Molde.

You can also fly to either Kristiansund or Ålesund and get a rental car or go by public transport, remember to check on public transport for the travel <https://frammr.no/?sprak=3>

- **Getting around**

Molde is a small village and Molde Climbing centre is located 15 minutes west of the city centre. All accommodation will be within 30 minutes' walk from Molde Climbing Centre. If you do not have a car, and
