45 € per athlete. The registration fee will be invoiced by the IFSC Europe to the National Federations. The registration fee will then increase to 95€ for each competitor.

How to get there: Access to the Competition Venue

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## By Train

Matabiau Station is an international railway station, easy to reach and directly connected to the city's public transport system.

From the station, you can reach the competition venue in about 45 minutes using public transport: first the Metro Line A, then Bus Line L3.

## By Plane

Toulouse Blagnac Airport is the largest airport in the region, located just a few steps from the competition.

- 15 minutes by car
- 1h10 by public transport (Airport Shuttle + Bus Line 63)

## By Bus

The cities of Toulouse and Tournefeuille share the same bus and metro network (Tisséo), making it easy and sustainable to reach the competition venue.

You can access the Espace des Quéfets directly with the following bus lines:

- Linéo 3
- Bus 48
- Bus 63
- Bus 116

We strongly encourage all delegations, athletes, staff, and spectators to use public transport.

- Buses run approximately every 15 minutes
- Metros run every 5 minutes

This solution is both efficient in the city and helps us reduce our carbon footprint (CO<sub>2</sub> emissions), in line with our sustainability commitment.

## SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

### Our Commitment to Sustainability

In line with our ambition to achieve the IFSC Europe Sustainability Award, sustainability is not just a guideline but a central value in the organisation of the European Cup in Tournefeuille.

#### The Venue

The competition will take place in the Espace des Quéfets, a low-energy certified facility built primarily from wood, including its structural frame and interior walls. Hemp-based panels have been used for thermal insulation, ensuring reduced energy consumption. Recycling bins will be placed throughout the venue to encourage waste sorting, and the catering area will highlight local, seasonal, and hand-made products.

#### Catering & Buvette

Our food offer follows an eco-conscious approach: local suppliers, reduced packaging, and a focus on vegetarian-friendly options. Reusable cups and dishes will be prioritized, in line with our zero single-use plastic policy.

#### Athlete Housing & Mobility

Athletes and staff will primarily be accommodated in facilities located within walking distance of the venue. For longer trips, we recommend using the well-developed urban transportation network, favoring public transportation over individual options. Carpooling and cycling will be encouraged among volunteers and the public.

#### Event Legacy

Beyond the event itself, our goal is to leave a positive legacy: raising awareness among the public and athletes about eco-responsible practices, supporting local businesses, and reusing competition materials (such as holds from other IFSC events).

This holistic approach reflects our belief that high-level sport can and must contribute to building a more sustainable future.
