The venue building is mainly made of wood including the supporting structure and the inside walls. Hemp based panels were used for thermal insulation. The building is low-energy classified.

As far as the venue is concerned recycling bins will be made available everywhere in the venue building and local and hand-made products will be served on site in the catering area.

As far as the athlete housing is concerned, the main buildings are very closed, walking distance from the venue building, CIME. Local transportation. Urban transport network is also well developed allowing for collective transportation rather than individual solution.
