## 3. REGISTRATION

**Licenses:** Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license may register for the competition.

**IFSC Online Registration System:** <https://ifsc.results.info/users/login>

**Registration Fee:** Registration fee is **30 \$ (USD)** for each competitor and for each discipline in which he/she competes. Fee will be paid by cash at Registration or through an online payment system (TBD)

**Registration Quota:** 5 participants + 2 youth (U19) per gender per NF per discipline. 2 extra for host NF per gender per discipline.

**Deadline:** The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") **on 6 November 2025 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.**

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

#### 4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

#### 5. ATTENDANCE CONFIRMATION

##### Delayed Arrival

##### Confirmation of Attendance

Physical confirmation of registration is mandatory. The Team Manager is responsible to communicate the presence of the National Team. The schedule and location of the conformation of attendance is outlined in the program of the event.

#### 7. HOW TO GET TO ARMENIA, QUINDIO, COLOMBIA

By plane:

**(a)** The airport destination is El Edén International Airport (AXM), located about 20 minutes from downtown Armenia.

**(b) Arriving in Pereira:** The airport destination is Matecaña International Airport (PEI), located in Pereira. From there, ground transportation is available to reach Armenia, with an approximate travel time of 1 hour and 30 minutes by road. This route offers a scenic journey through



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Colombia's coffee region and is a convenient alternative for accessing events or accommodations in Armenia.

(c) Arriving in Cali: The airport destination is Alfonso Bonilla Aragón International Airport (CLO), located in Cali. From there, you can take a domestic flight to El Edén International Airport (AXM), which is about 20 minutes from downtown Armenia. There are also ground transportation options available, with an approximate duration of 3 hours and 30 minutes.

(d) Arriving in Bogotá: The airport destination is El Dorado International Airport (BOG), located in Bogotá. From there, you can take a domestic flight to El Edén International Airport (AXM), which is about 20 minutes from downtown Armenia. There are also ground transportation options available, with an approximate duration of 6 hours.
