EVENT INVITATION	<p>The team competition is based on IFSC invitation to the National Federations. The invitation will follow the 2024 Team Ranking for Boulder and Lead, where the points of the two disciplines will be cumulated. National Teams will be invited to the competition and they will be required to provide an official answer by the deadline communicated by the IFSC. In case of refusal to participation, or missing answer, the IFSC will invite the next National Team available.</p>
IFSC NATIONS GRAND FINALE QUOTAS	<p>The IFSC Nations Grand Finale will award two set of medals: Lead and Boulder. Each National team will be composed by the following members:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Two (2) MEN athletes- Two (2) WOMEN athletes- OPTIONAL = One (1) reserve athlete per gender <p>Each Country might decide to propose the same team competing in both Boulder and Lead disciplines, or to propose two different teams. The detailed rules of the event will be released during the oncoming weeks. Each National Federation could also register Team Officials in the maximum numbers and capacity following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) one (1) Team Manager;b) four (4) coaches;c) two (2) qualified medical or para-medical personnel <p>Licences: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international licence are allowed to register for the competition.</p>
TEAM EVENT FORMAT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The competition will be divided in different rounds: Qualification, Elimination heats (TBC) and finals

BOULDER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For each round, the team will climb the available boulders divided in pairs (4 to 6 total boulders). Every boulder will be climbed by two athletes It is responsibility of the coach to allocate the different athletes to the boulders The climbing time is fixed to 5 minutes per Boulder The maximum possible score for each boulder is 50 points (2 athletes * 25 points) The score of the team is provided by the sum of the different athletes' score, for all rotations The athletes can talk, share betas and information. They autonomously decide how to organize their climbing time. The coaches can talk with athletes
TEAM EVENT FORMAT LEAD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The competition will be divided in different rounds: Qualification, Elimination heats (TBC) and finals For each round, the team will climb the available routes (2 to 3) divided in pairs The score of the team will be given by adding the scores of each single athlete
PARA CLIMBING MASTER	<p>Open categories: Men: B1, AU2, AL2, RP1 Women: B2, AU2, AL2, RP1</p> <p>It should be noted that the event will not strictly follow IFSC merging rules. Sport classes might be merged and combined depending on event needs. Lead wall will be able to host two routes for Para Climbing Qualifications.</p> <p>Licences: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international licence are allowed to register for the competition. 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	<p>Team Event – athletes’ grants</p> <p>The final contribution for each National Team will be confirmed at the registration deadline. The <u>minimum guaranteed contribution</u> is fixed to the following amount:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Host Country / Team JPN = 1500€ - National Teams coming from the Asian Continent = 3500€ for each National Team - National Teams coming from other Continents = 6500€ for each National Team <p>The contribution will be released by the IFSC to each National Federation. It should be noted that the contribution will not be based on the size of each National team.</p> <p>Para Climbing event</p> <p>The Para Climbing athletes attending the event will receive free accommodation for the event duration: from October 22nd to 27th. Athletes requiring to extend their stay beyond the event scope will be required to pay for the extra nights. The Para Climbing athletes are required to officially confirm to the hotel by Monday 15 September 2025 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.</p> <p>The maximum number of athletes entitled to receive free accommodation is fixed to 50. In case where the number of athletes registered to the event exceeds such amount, the free accommodation will be released on a first-come first-serve basis. The reference for athletes’ participation will be the time of registration in the IFSC result system.</p> <p>Further contribution might be released by the IFSC, after the conclusion of the event. The final contribution for each athlete will depend to the number of athletes competing at the event. The contribution will be released by the IFSC to each National Federation, who will be responsible to transfer it to the athletes</p>
