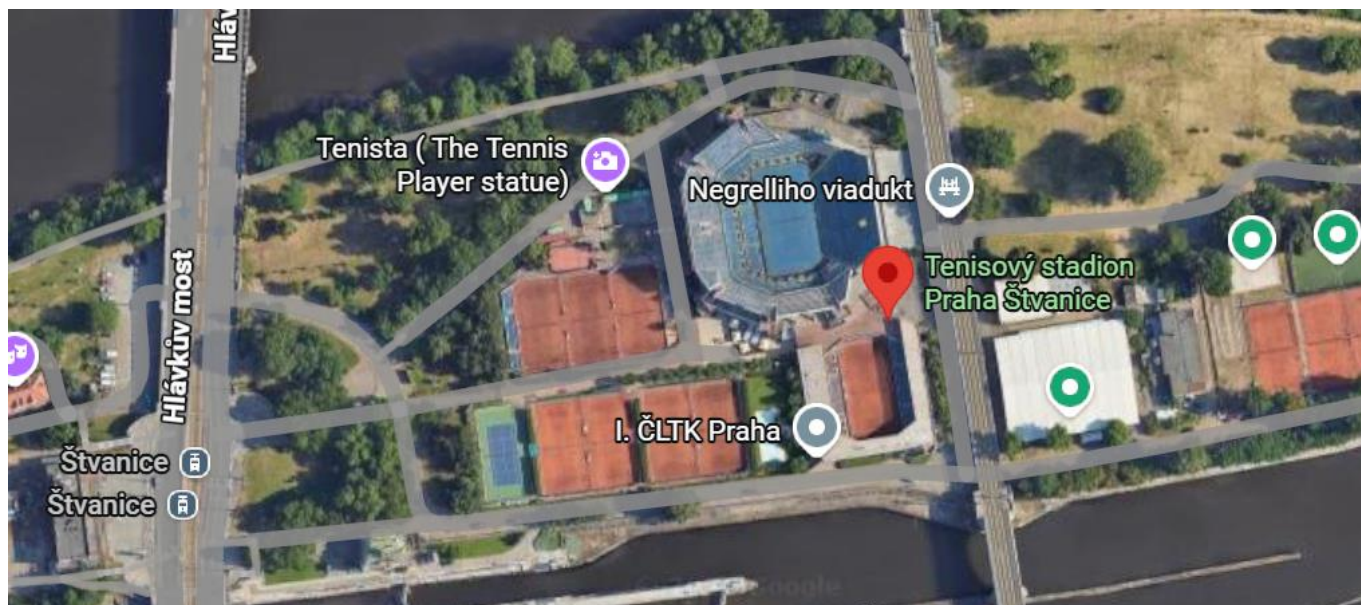

2.2. Technical Meeting

Location:

The venue for all Technical Meetings is at the Tennis Stadium, directly at the competition venue. The exact location will be communicated.

IMPORTANT: Please note that a maximum of two (2) National Team Officials per Country will be allowed to access the Technical Meeting.

2.3. Confirmation of Participation

Location: Same location as the Technical Meeting

Confirmation of participation is mandatory for each discipline and must be done in person by the Head of Delegation. In case a National Team did not register the Head of Delegation, another member of the National Team shall be appointed to confirm attendance of the Team. In case of emergencies and late arrival, the Event Delegate must be informed immediately. Failure to provide this information in a timely manner may result in the athletes not being permitted to compete. A digital copy of the athletes' passports shall be provided at the confirmation of participation. Failure to provide this information in a timely manner may result in the athletes not being permitted to compete. A digital copy of the athletes' passports shall be provided upon confirmation of participation.

IMPORTANT: Confirmation of participation for each discipline is outlined in the event programme. Athletes may only be confirmed in the discipline for which the confirmation is taking place, provided they are duly registered in that discipline. It will not be possible to confirm athletes for other disciplines during a different confirmation season.

2.4. Contingency Plan

The World Climbing Series Prague is an **outdoor event**, and the safety of athletes, officials, and spectators is our highest priority. We are in constant coordination with local emergency services regarding all security matters, as well as the

Czech Hydrometeorological Institute to monitor changing conditions in real time. Based on the data provided and in close communication with World Climbing Officials, we are prepared with several options for rescheduling competition rounds. Any changes to the schedule will be communicated to the teams immediately via official channels.

In the event of a sudden weather change, athletes and officials can utilize the indoor facilities of the Štvanice Tennis Stadium, where the warm-up is located, to ensure they remain in a safe and controlled environment.

3. Deadlines and quotas

3.1. Registration deadline

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the “Registration Date”) on **19 May 2026 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**. Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

3.2. Valid athletes' international licence

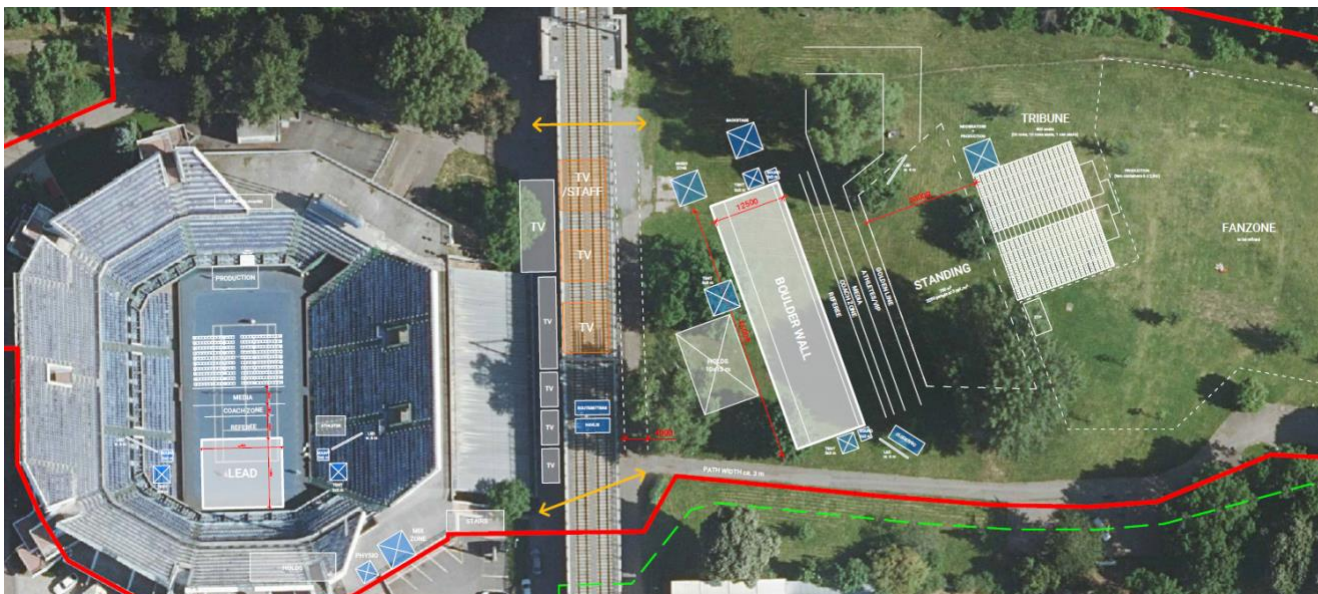
Licences: Only competitors and team officials with a valid World Climbing International licence and approved medical status are allowed to register for the competition.

4. Sport Information

4.1. Venue information





Venue Location: Štvanice, 170 00 Praha 7

The World Climbing Series Prague 2026 is hosted at the Štvanice Tennis Stadium, an outdoor location situated on Štvanice Island. The venue layout utilizes both the stadium infrastructure and the adjacent parkland. The Lead wall is located outdoors on the Centre Court of the tennis stadium. The Boulder wall is situated in the park area located immediately next to the tennis stadium. This area is also outdoors and provides space for spectator engagement and movement, including the official Fan Zone.

4.2. Warm-up zone

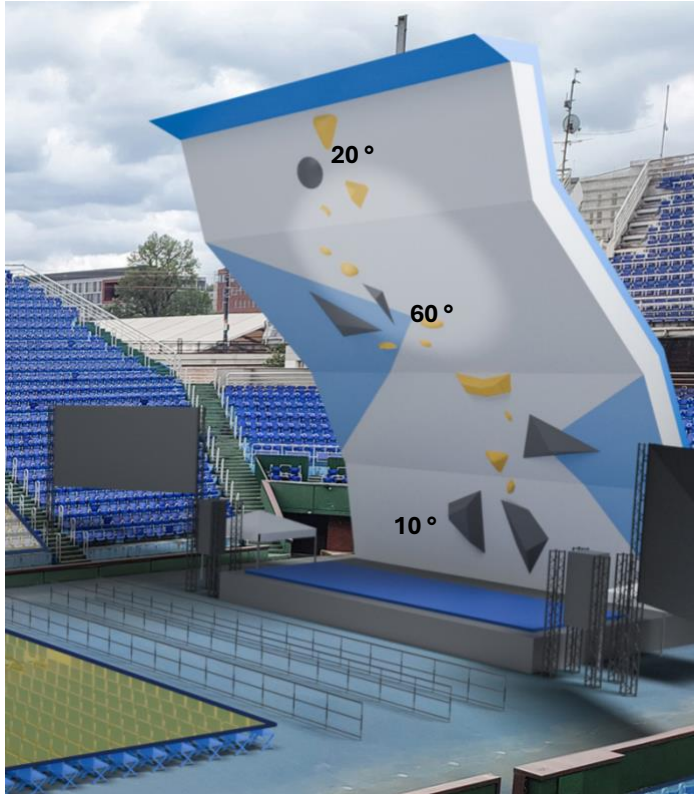
The Warm-up Zone will be hosted within the indoor facilities of the Štvanice Tennis Stadium. These indoor facilities will also house the Medical Room and additional athlete amenities.

The warm-up zone includes a boulder wall (15m wide, 0, 10, 20 degrees), a Kilter Board, and a dedicated space for stretching. To support athlete performance and recovery, drinks and snacks will also be provided in this area. The area of the warm-up zone is 300 sqm².



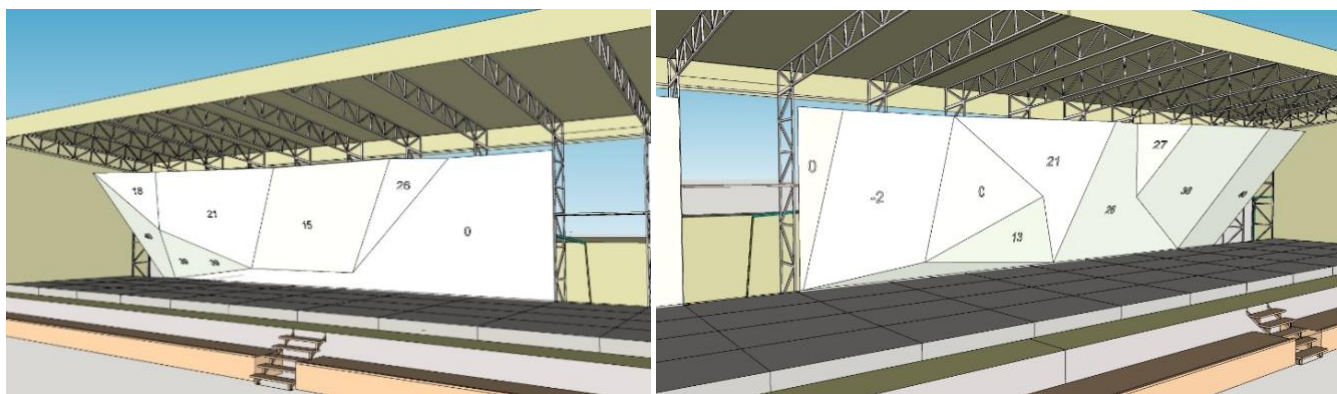

5.3. Transport

To reach the venue, we recommend using Prague's public transport system:

- Tram: Take a tram to the stop **Štvanice**, which is located on the bridge directly above the island.
- Metro: The nearest station is **Florenc** (Lines B and C). From there, it is a 10-minute walk to the venue.

Limited parking will be available for teams on the Štvanice island next to the venue, parking cards will be given out after the respective technical meeting.

Tickets will be needed for the following events:

- **Boulder:** Semi-Final and Final
- **Lead:** Qualification, Semi-Final, and Final

Registered World Climbing athletes and team officials will not need to purchase tickets for these events. However, please note that accreditation is required for all rounds. For the Boulder qualification, which is held outdoors, event accreditation will not be needed. Please be aware that access to the venue is limited due to capacity restrictions and will be managed on a first-come, first-served basis.
