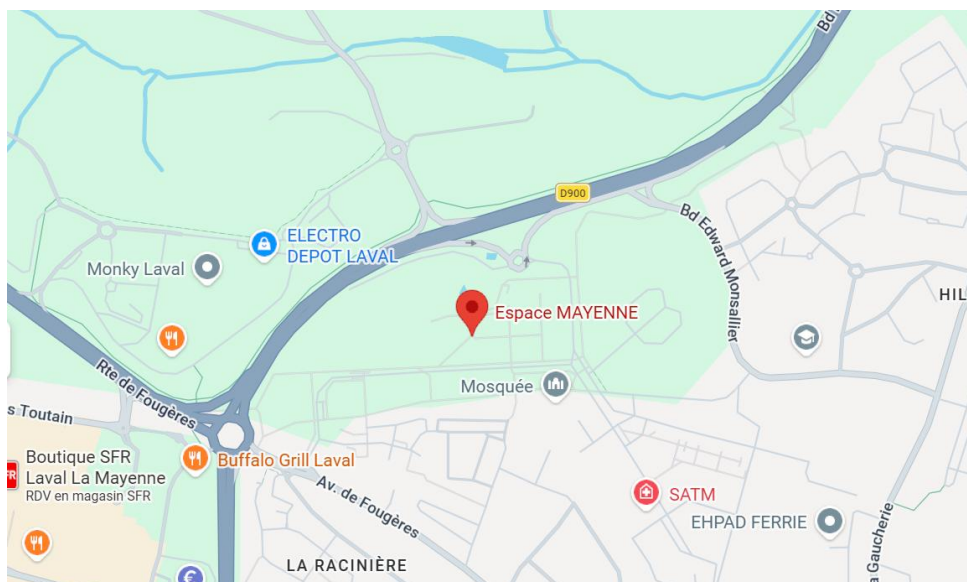

Confirmation of attendance is mandatory and must be done in person by the Head of Delegation. In case a National Team did not register the Head of Delegation, another member of the National Team shall be appointed to confirm attendance of the Team. In case of emergencies and late arrival, the Event Delegate must be informed immediately. Failure to provide this information in a timely manner may result in the athletes not being permitted to compete. A digital copy of the athletes' passports shall be provided at the confirmation of attendance.

3. Deadlines and quotas

3.1. Registration deadline

The deadline for registration is 42 days before the first day of competition on **July 17th at 11.59PM UTC+0**

Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, National Federations may, in case of unforeseen events, replace Team Officials or Sight Guide.

This replacement must be in the same role and submitted by email at sport@worldclimbing.com; and for Sight Guides the following conditions apply:

- Sight Guides may not be replaced with another Sight Guide already paired with a competing athlete (art 4.9 of the Para Climbing Regulation);
- The substitute Sight Guide must hold a valid license and be of the same nationality as the competing athlete.

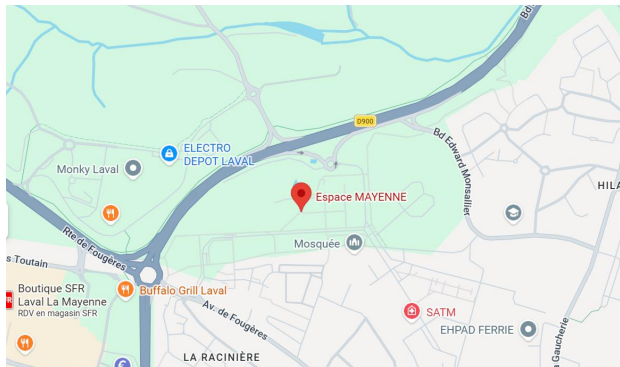
3.2. Valid athletes' international licence

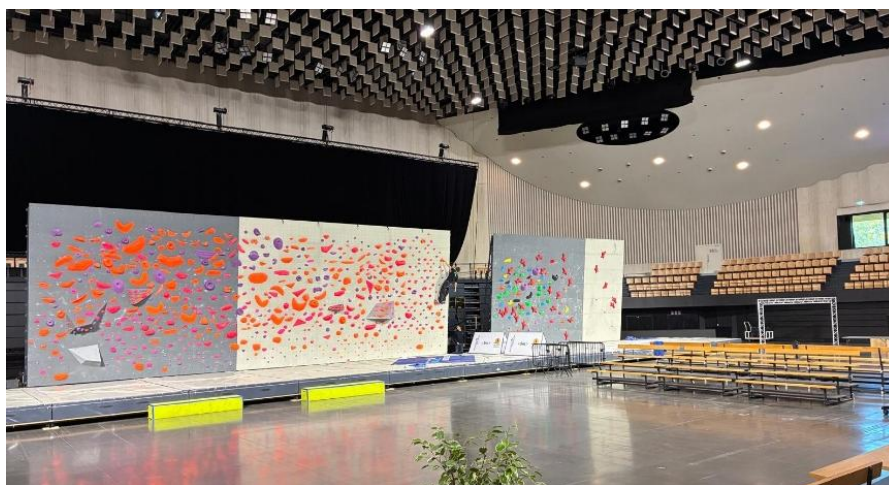
