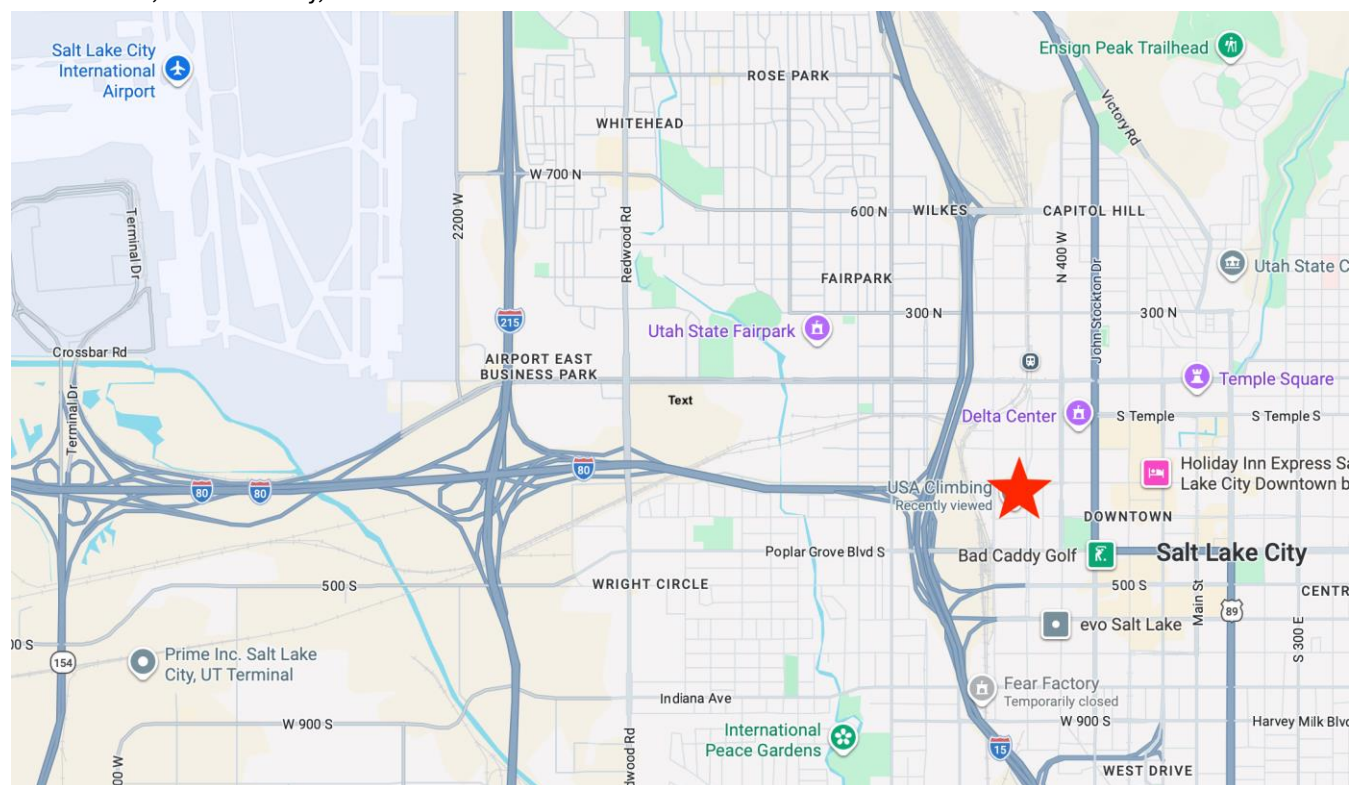

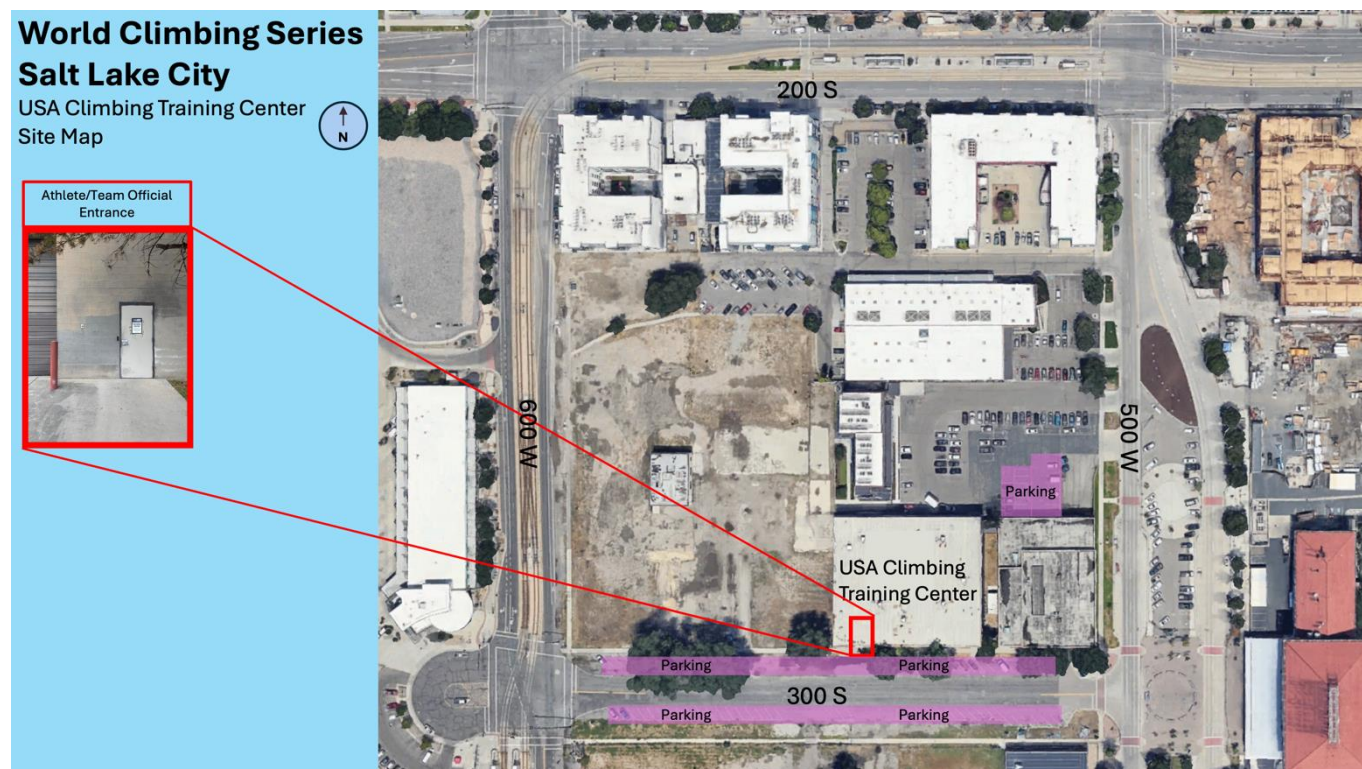


The venue for the Confirmation of Attendance and all Technical Meetings is approximately a 10-minute drive by car from the Salt Lake City International Airport and from the climbing venue.

Confirmation of attendance is mandatory for each discipline and must be done in person by the Head of Delegation. In case a National Team did not register the Head of Delegation, another member of the National Team shall be appointed to confirm attendance of the Team. In case of emergencies and late arrival, the Event Delegate must be

informed immediately. Failure to provide this information in a timely manner may result in the athletes not being permitted to compete. A digital copy of the athletes' passports shall be provided at the confirmation of attendance.

3. Deadlines and quotas

3.1. Registration deadline

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **October 1st at 11:59 PM UTC+0**. Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid World Climbing international license and approved medical status are allowed to register for the competition. **Online Registration System:** <https://ifsc.results.info/users/login>

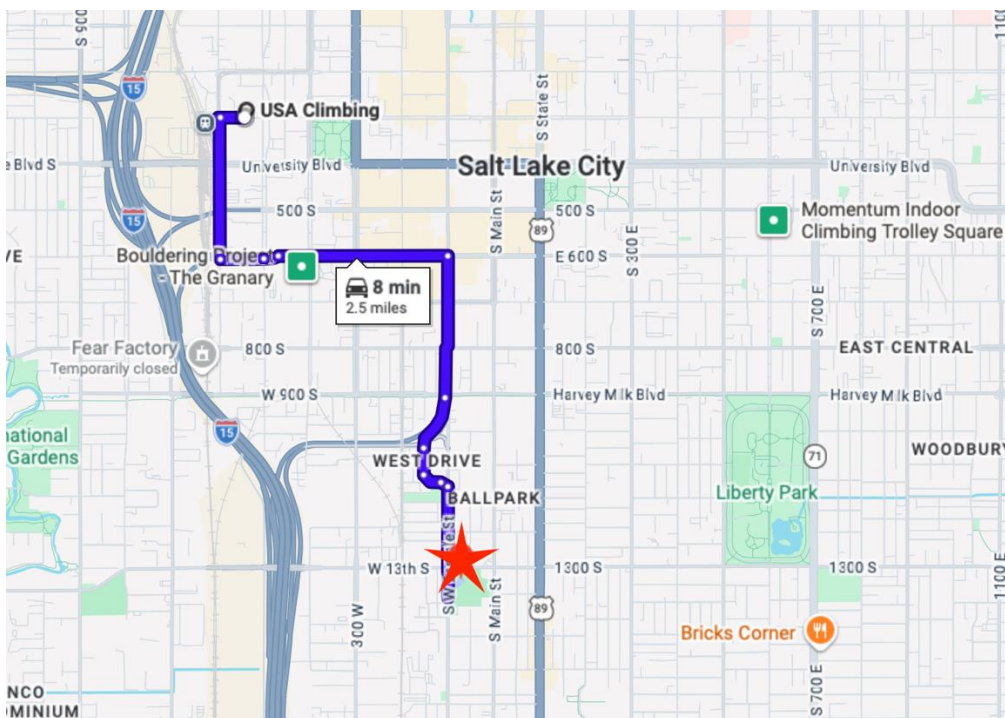
4. Sport Information

Scheduling Visa Appointments:

- If an applicant is not able to schedule a visa appointment before their date of travel, they can request an expedited appointment. To request an expedite, the applicant must first schedule a regular appointment (even if it is beyond the date of travel), and then re-enter the scheduling system and select the "Request Expedite/Emergency Appointment" option;
- When requesting an expedite, applicants must clearly explain their reason for travel and dates of travel to the U.S.;
- Applicants can also consider applying in a third-country location with shorter wait-times. There is no penalty for applying anywhere appointments are available, even outside one's home country.

5.3. Transport

5.5. Accreditations

Teams will be provided with their accreditation at the confirmation of attendance. Team Managers are requested to collect the badges for their entire team and distribute them accordingly. Credentials will be required by all team officials and athletes for entry into the competition venue.

5.6. Tickets

Tickets for the World Climbing Series Salt Lake City event will be released in the Summer of 2026!

- Men/Women’s Boulder Qualifications
- Men/Women’s Boulder Semi-Finals



- Men/Women's Boulder Finals

Registered World Climbing athletes and team officials will not need to purchase tickets for these events. However, please note that accreditation is required to access the event venue.
