2.3. Confirmation of Participation

3. Deadlines and quotas

3.1. Registration deadline

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **8 October 2026 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**. Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

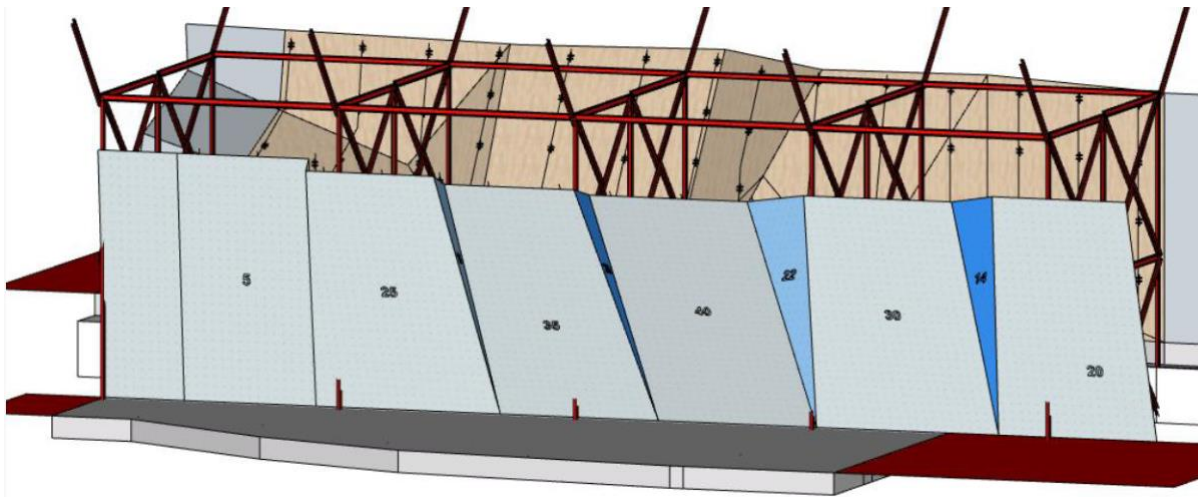

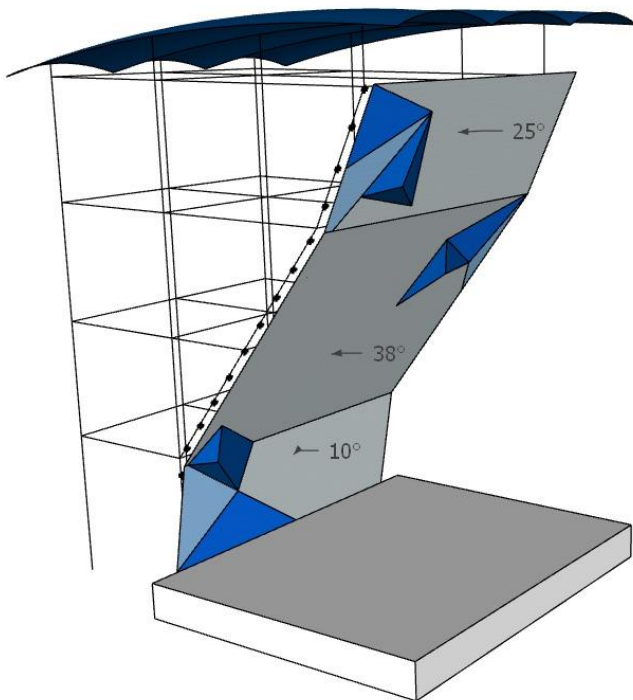
4.2. Warm-up zone
