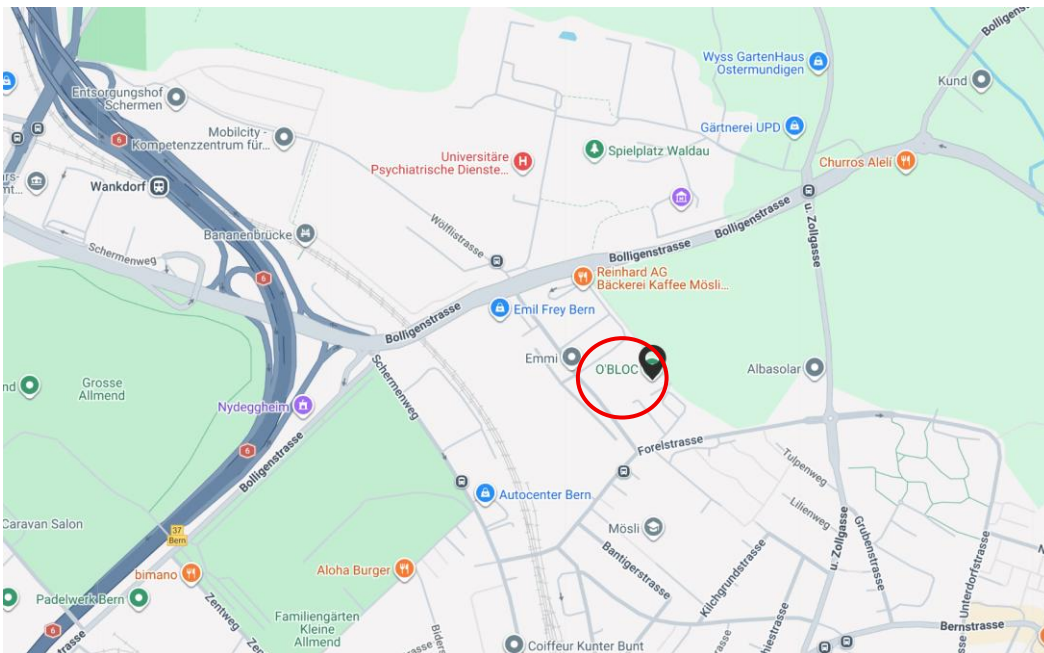

Physical confirmation of registration is mandatory. The Team Manager is responsible to communicate the presence of the National Team. In case of late arrival please contact the World Climbing Event Delegate as soon as possible.

Although the confirmation of attendance for Boulder and Lead takes place on separate days, the event accreditation for registered team members can be picked up on any day when the accreditation is available. With your accreditation badge, you have access to the spectator area of the event during the whole week. Accreditation opening hours will be published on our website.

IMPORTANT: If you pick up your accreditation for the event already before the designated registration time, your attendance is not confirmed automatically! You will still need to confirm your attendance, either in person during the above-mentioned registration time or via message to the Event Delegate.

3. Deadlines and quotas

3.1. Registration deadline

10 days before the first day of the event, August 11th, 2026, at 23:59 pm CET.

Registration Fees: €45,- per athlete. The registration fee will be invoiced by the World Climbing Europe to the National Federations. In case of late registration please get in direct contact with europa.events@ifsc-climbing.org to forward the athletes you want to register. A late registration surcharge of €95 will be applied for each competitor in addition to the standard registration fee.

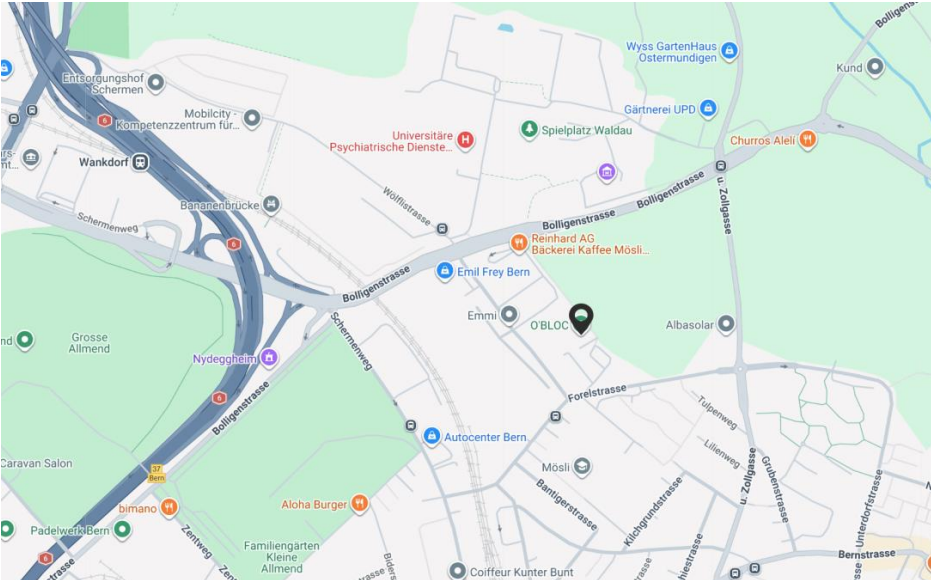
