Registration Fees

The registration fee is EUR 55.00 per athlete and will be invoiced by World Climbing Europe to the National Federations.

The European Championship will be conducted in accordance with the same competition format as [the World Series and the World Championship](#).

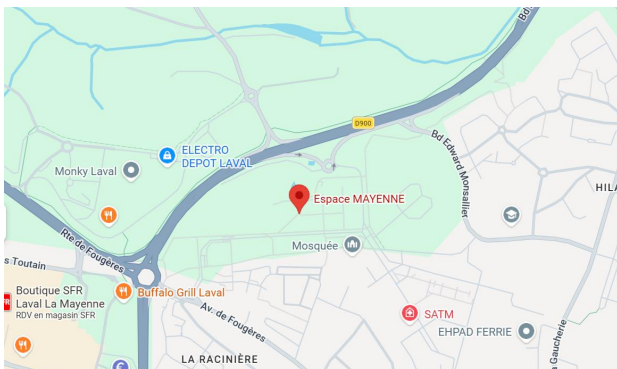
Each National Federation is entitled to register a maximum of four (4) athletes per gender and per discipline.

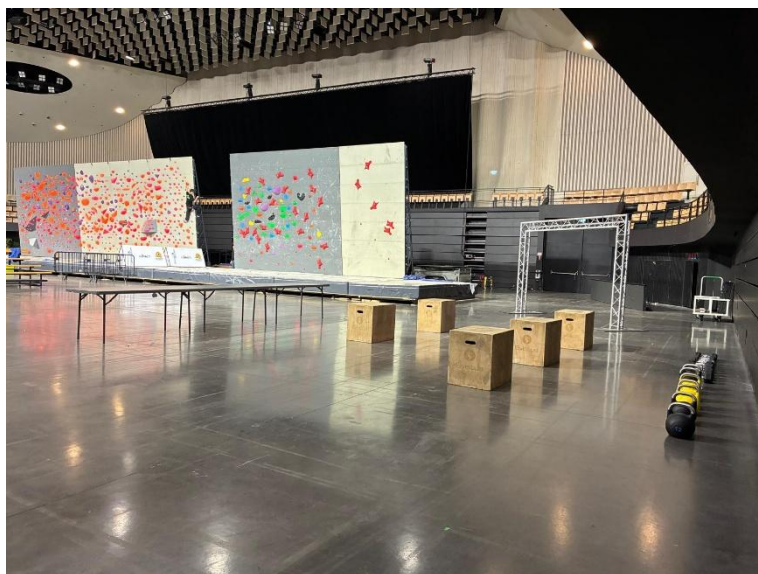
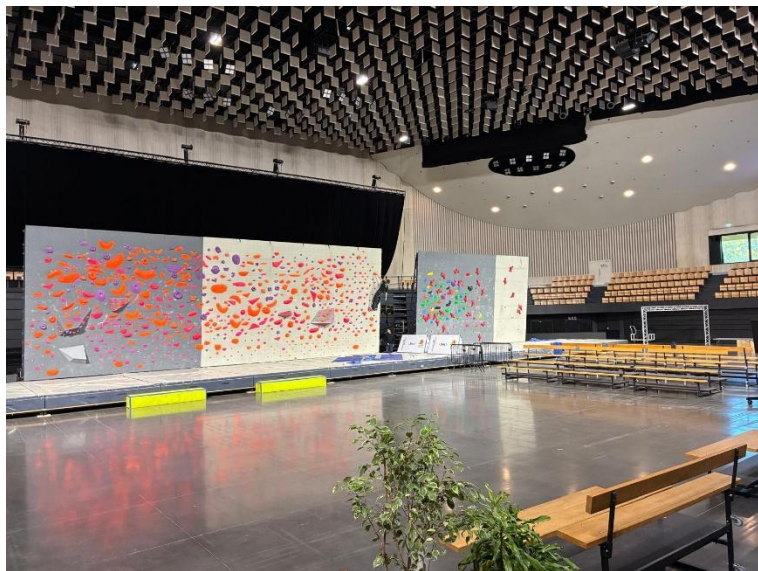
