2.2. Contingency day

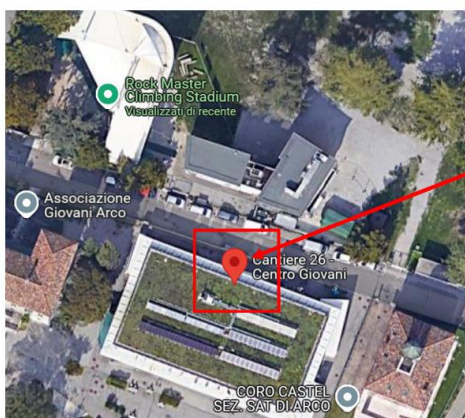
Considering the specificity of the venue and the importance of the event, all National Teams competing in Lead and Speed shall reserve one contingency day in their planning. The contingency day might be used for competition purposes, in case some of the rounds need to be postponed. Therefore:

- All National Teams competing in Lead are expected to remain onsite through Tuesday, 21 July (included) and plan their departure for Wednesday, 22 July.
- All National Teams competing in Speed shall remain onsite through Wednesday, 22 July (included) and schedule their departure for Thursday, 23 July.

2.3. Technical Meeting and confirmation of attendance

Location:

Cantiere 26 - Youth Center, Via Paolina Caproni Maini, 26/E, 38062 Arco



The venue for all Technical Meetings is approximately a 3 minutes walking from the climbing venue.

IMPORTANT: Please note that the Technical Meeting is reserved for registered National Team Officials.

Confirmation of attendance is mandatory for each discipline and must be done in person by the Head of Delegation. In case a National Team did not register the Head of Delegation, another member of the National Team shall be appointed to confirm attendance of the Team. In case of emergencies and late arrival, the Event Delegate must be informed immediately. Failure to provide this information in a timely manner may result in the athletes not being permitted to compete. A digital copy of the athletes' passports shall be provided at the confirmation of attendance.

IMPORTANT: Confirmation of attendance for each discipline is outlined in the event programme below. Athletes may only be confirmed in the discipline for which the confirmation is taking place, provided they are duly registered in that discipline. It will not be possible to confirm athletes for other disciplines during a different confirmation session.

3. Deadlines and quotas

3.1. Registration deadline

Member Federations may register eligible Team Members in the numbers and capacity following:

- A) Team Officials
 - 1) One (1) Team Manager;
 - 2) Three (3) Coaches per discipline;
 - 3) Three (3) qualified Medical Personnel
- B) Competitors
 - 1) any current Youth World Champion, in the Discipline for which they are champion; and
 - 2) a further three (3) competitors for each Category of the competition

Licences: Only competitors and team officials with a valid World Climbing international licence and approved medical status are allowed to register for the competition. Online Registration System: [link](#).

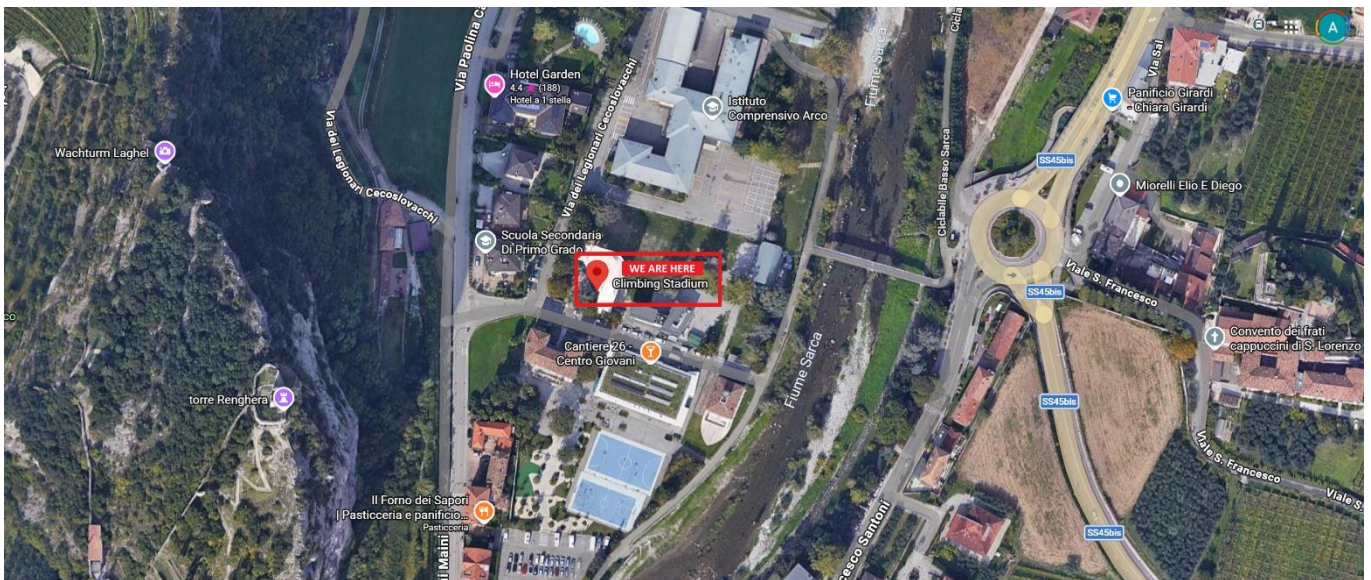
Deadline: The deadline for registration is one month before the first day of competition (the “Registration Date”) on 18th June 2026 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.

Following the Registration Date and until the 8th July 2026 at 11:59 PM UTC+0, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

The World Climbing Office may authorise late registrations between the registration deadline and Thursday, 25 June at 23:59 CEST (UTC+2) at the latest. Late-registration requests must be officially submitted by the National Federation, and may be accepted upon payment of a late-registration fee of €200 per athlete, per discipline, and per gender.

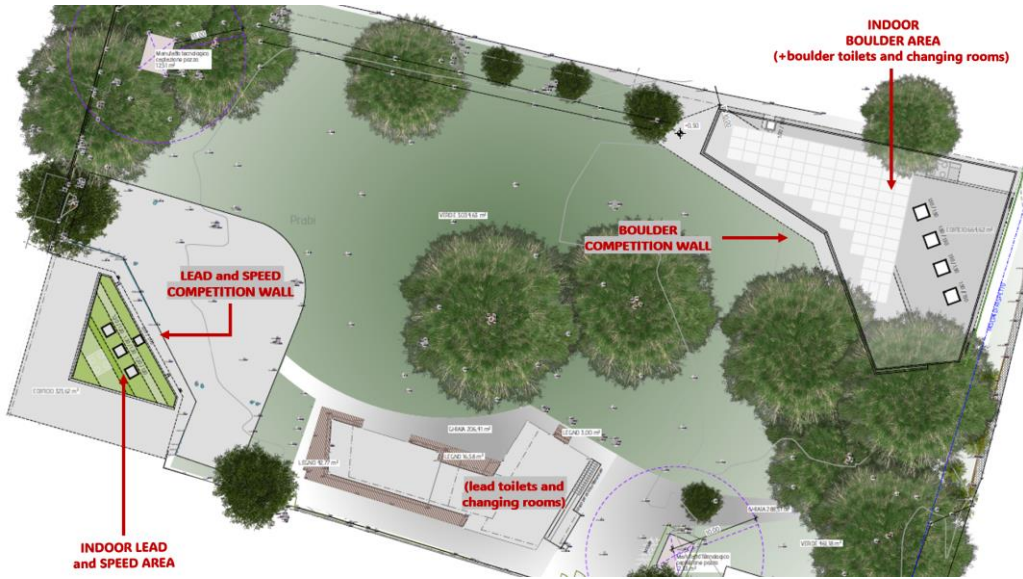

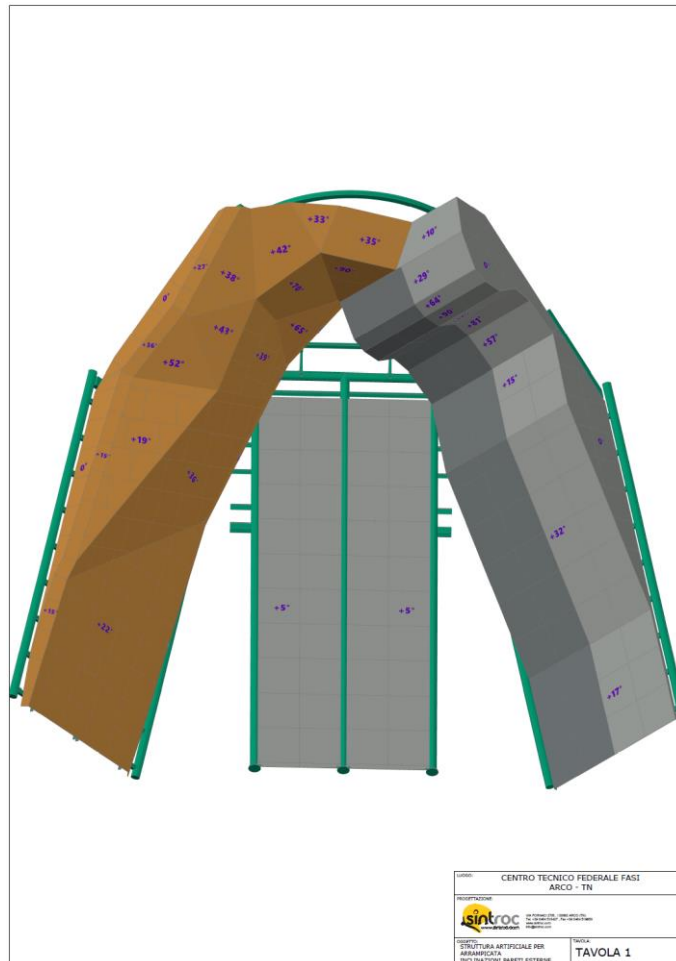
Competition Areas



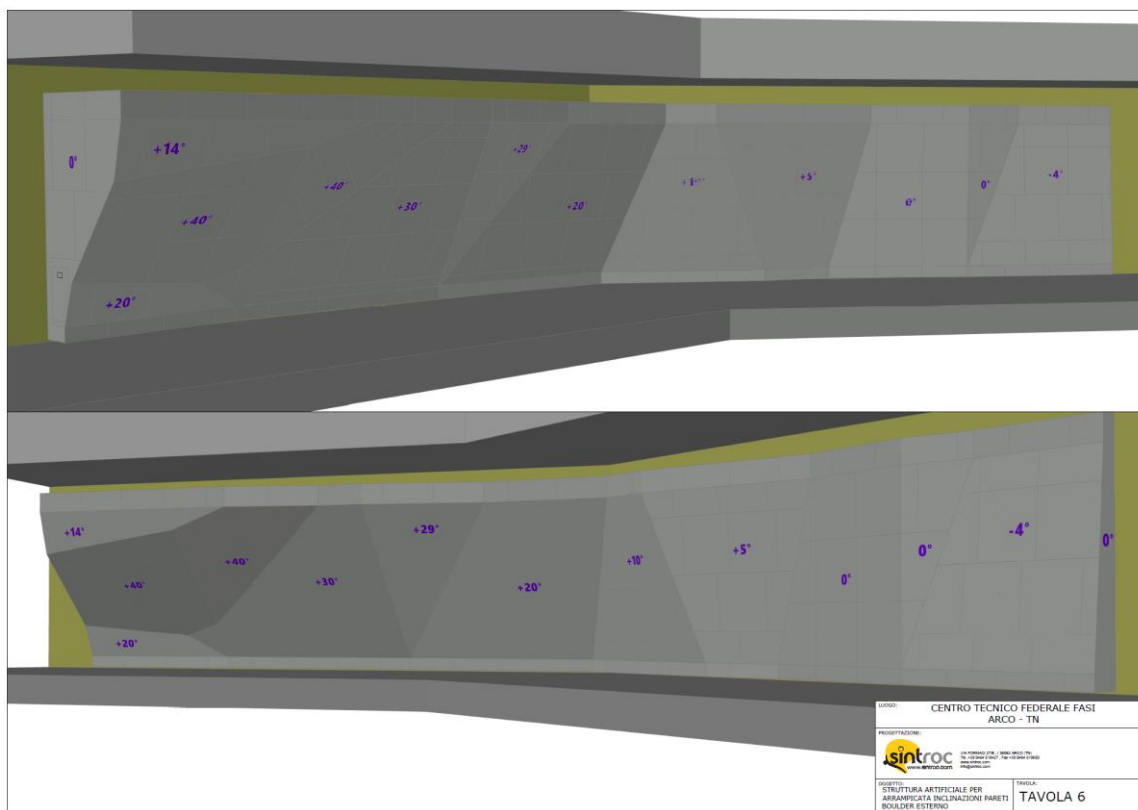

4.2.1. Lead and Speed Competition Wall



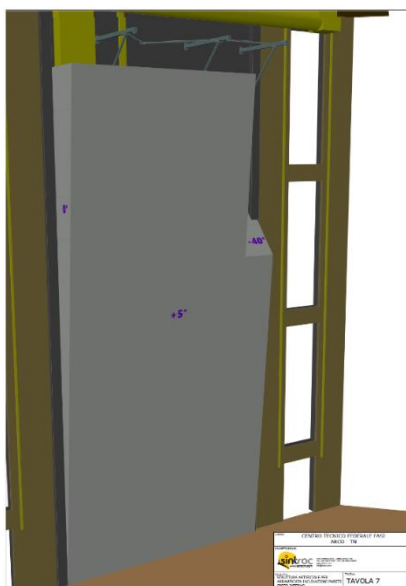
4.2.1. Boulder Competition Wall

4.3. Warm-up walls

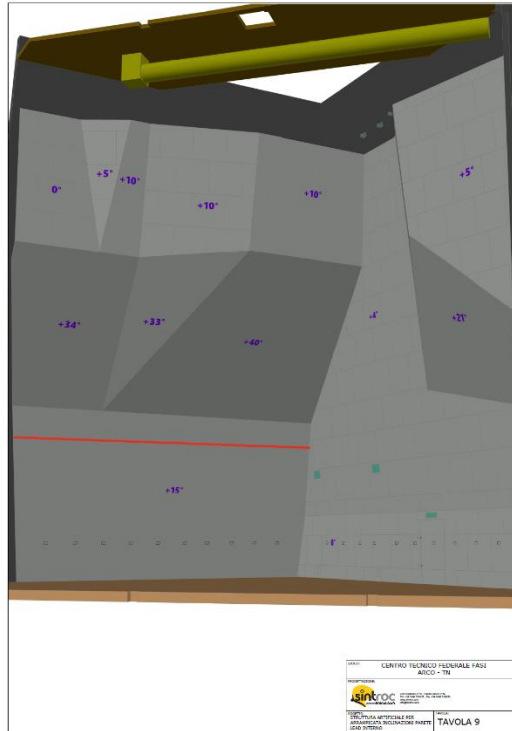
4.3.1. Speed Indoor Warm-Up Wall



It will be set up with two competition lines and some half lines, the holds will be identical to those of the competition wall, there will be autobelay, timer and volunteers available for safety.

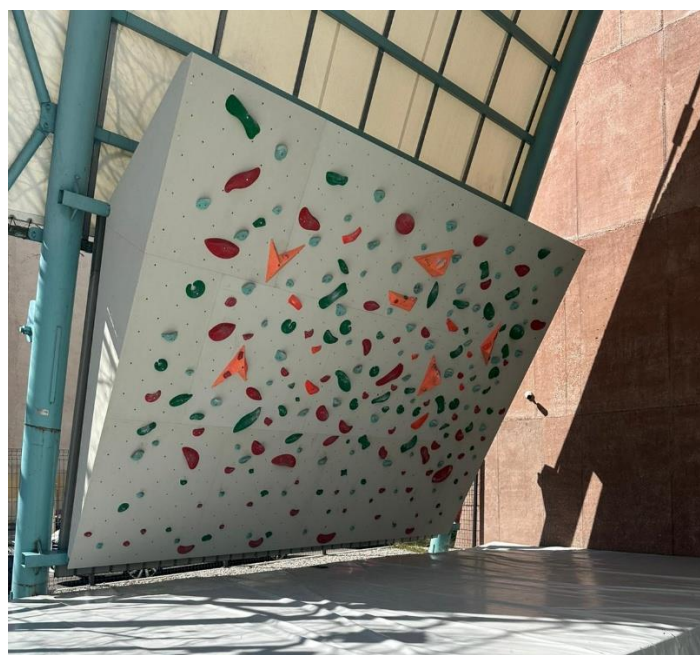
Speed competitors can use also the outdoor and indoor spray walls

4.3.2. Lead Indoor Warm-Up Wall

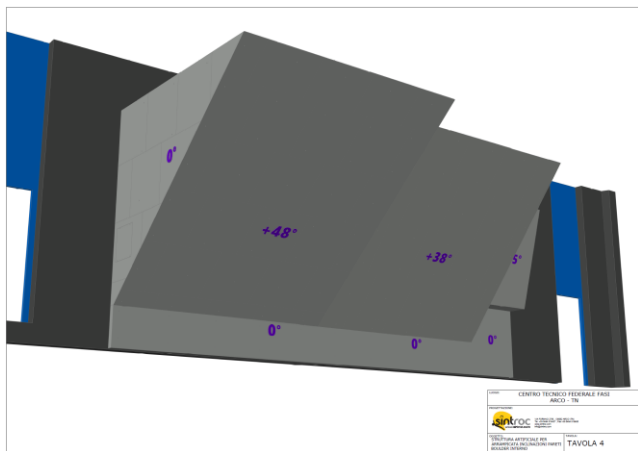


It will be set up with a 10-meter spray wall at 15° (using the lead wall up to 4 meters, see red line in photo) and mats. A few indoor routes will be available on the right side of the wall.

Just outside the main lead hall, athletes will have access to another smaller spray wall at 30° and a 12x12 Kilter Board

5. Boulder Qualifications

With reference to article 2.3 of annex C of the World Climbing competition regulations, Boulder qualifications will be run with a total of five (5) boulders, divided in two courses, with flash format. In details:

- a) Course A will be composed by three (3) boulders, with Random Order startlist;
- b) Course B will be composed by two (2) boulders, with Offset Order
- c) The ranking for the qualification round will be calculated from the total points accumulated by each competitor across courses A and B.
- d) Climbing time is fixed to four (4) minutes, with a fixed rotation time of fifteen (15) seconds
- e) There should be a minimum time gap of 50 minutes between the scheduled completion of a competitor's attempts on their first course and their scheduled start on the second course.
- f) Each boulder must be demonstrated by forerunners on a video recording:
 - available online via an electronic link provided to all teams, and/or
 - continuously played back in the warm-up area,
 and in each case these videos must be made available at least 60 minutes before the actual Start of Play. It is not necessary that these demonstrations show a successful `ground-up` attempt on the boulder.

6.3. Travel information

By plane:

The nearest airport to Arco is Verona (VRN) Airport which is 57.2 km away. Other nearby airports are Milan Bergamo (BGY) (96.2 km), Venice (VCE) (121.8 km), Milan Linate (LIN) (134.8 km) and Milan Malpensa (MXP) (171.7 km).

By train:

Verona - Brennero line: get off at Rovereto station. Here is possible to take the bus to Arco. Stop in front of the station.

By car:

- A22 Brennero - Modena motorway: exit at Rovereto Sud (Lake di Garda north), then continue on the SS240 state road towards Mori - Riva del Garda – Arco
- From the south-east of the lake, continue along the eastern gardesana SS249 (Peschiera - Garda - Malcesine - Torbole - Riva del Garda - Arco).
- From the south-west of the lake, continue along the western gardesana SS45bis (Brescia - Salò - Limone - Riva del Garda - Arco).
