COMPETITION REGULATIONS	<p>The competition will be carried out according to the latest World Climbing Rules.</p> <p>Athletes must wear the official competition bib provided. Bibs must be visible at all times while on the field of play.</p> <p>Athlete Attire:</p> <p>Athletes must compete in appropriate climbing attire. Clothing must be suitable for a sporting environment and free from offensive, inappropriate, or discriminatory language, images, or symbols.</p>
ANTI-DOPING	<p>The competition is subject to World Climbing Anti-Doping Regulations in compliance with the World Anti-Doping Code (WADA).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athletes may be tested at any time during the event. • All participants are required to comply fully with these rules.

APPEALS	<p>Appeals must be submitted in line with World Climbing Regulations.</p> <p>Appeals are lodged by the Team Manager/Coach to the Jury President within the required timeframe, with a deposit of \$100 AUD cash</p> <p>Decisions of the Jury President are final.</p>

ADDITIONAL: AUSTRALIAN BOULDER CHAMPIONSHIP	<p>The event will be run as a double-header, comprising the 2026 Oceania Boulder Cup and the 2026 Australian Boulder Championships.</p> <p>Podium eligibility is as follows:</p> <p>Oceania Boulder Cup Podium: Open to Australian National Team members who are citizens, New Zealand National Team members, and Guam National Team members.</p> <p>Australian Boulder Championships Podium: Open to Australian citizens and Australian permanent residents.</p> <p>Event Boulder Championships Open to Australian permanent residents, Australian citizens</p> <p>To manage eligibility and results for non-Australian athletes, Sport Climbing Australia may score the event using both the SCA scoring system and the World Climbing scoring system.</p>
