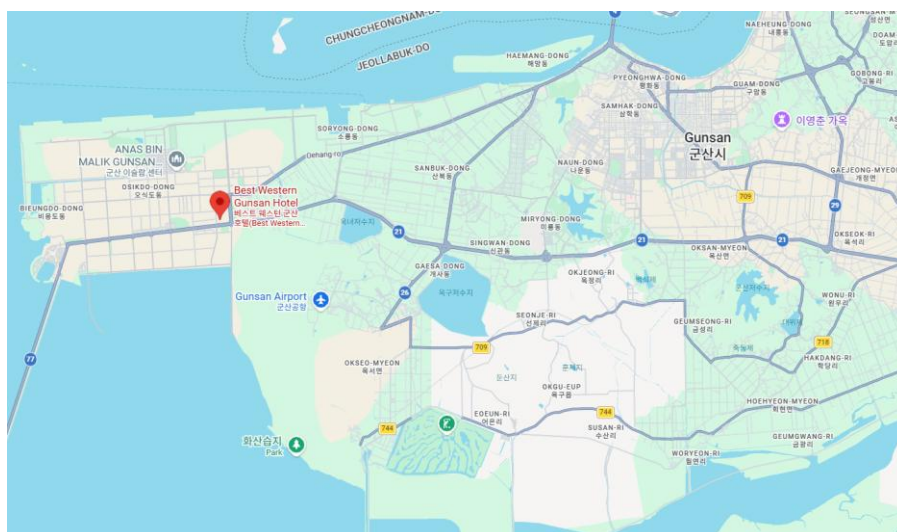
2.2. Technical Meeting

2.3. Confirmation of Attendance

Although the confirmation of attendance for Boulder and Speed takes place on separate days, the event accreditation for registered team members can be picked up on any day when the accreditation is available. With your accreditation badge, you have access to the spectator area of the event during the whole week. Accreditation opening hours will be published on our website.

IMPORTANT: If you pick up your accreditation for the event already before the designated registration time, your attendance is not confirmed automatically! You will still need to confirm your attendance, either in person during the above-mentioned registration time or via message to the Event Delegate.

Member Federations may register eligible Team Members in the numbers and capacity following:

A) Team Officials

- 1) one (1) Team Manager;
- 2) four (4) coaches per Discipline;
- 3) four (4) qualified medical

B) Competitors

- 1) Member Federation: Up to 8 Competitors per gender category/discipline
- 2) Host Federation: Up to 12 Competitors per gender category/discipline

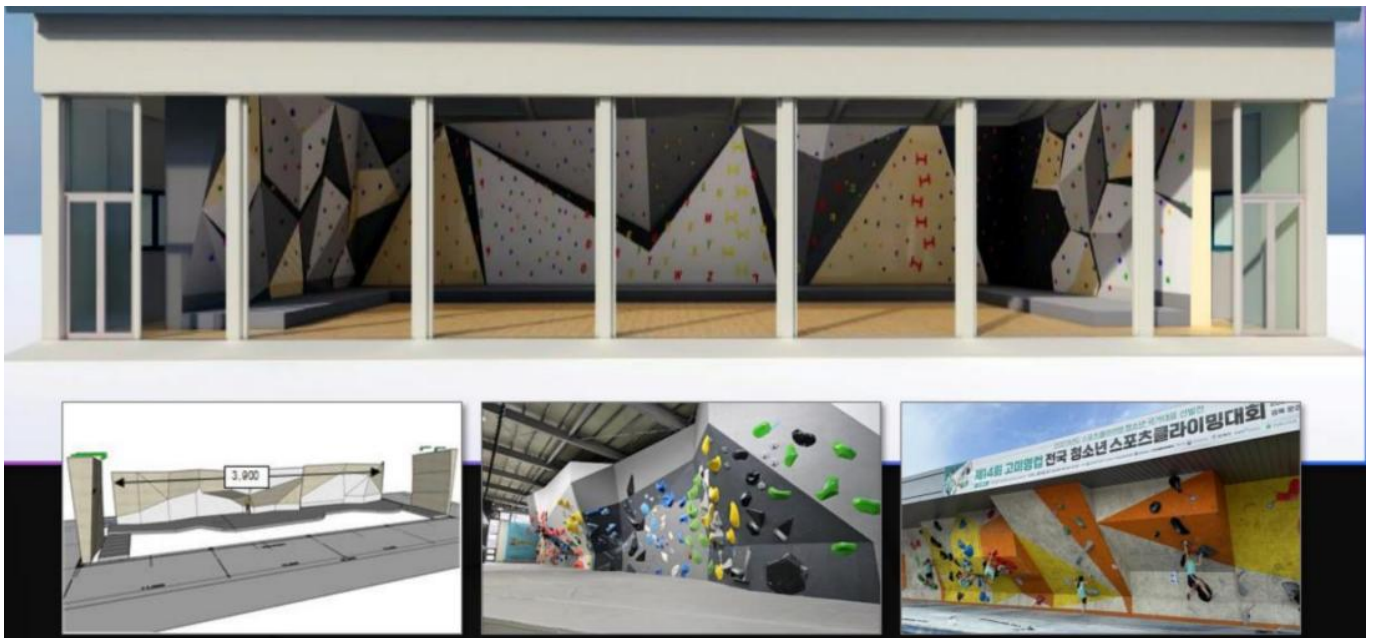
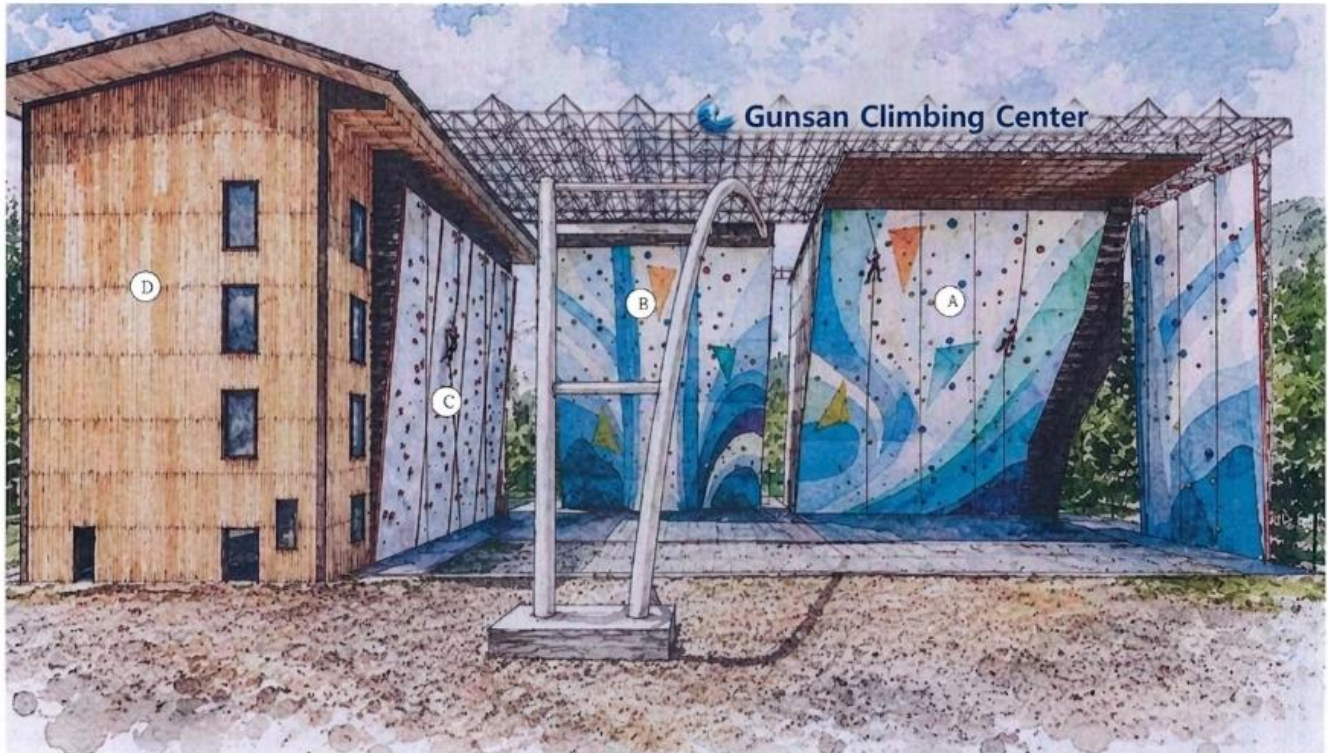
- A** Outdoor Lead Wall · L16.0 H16.8

- G** Spectator Zone

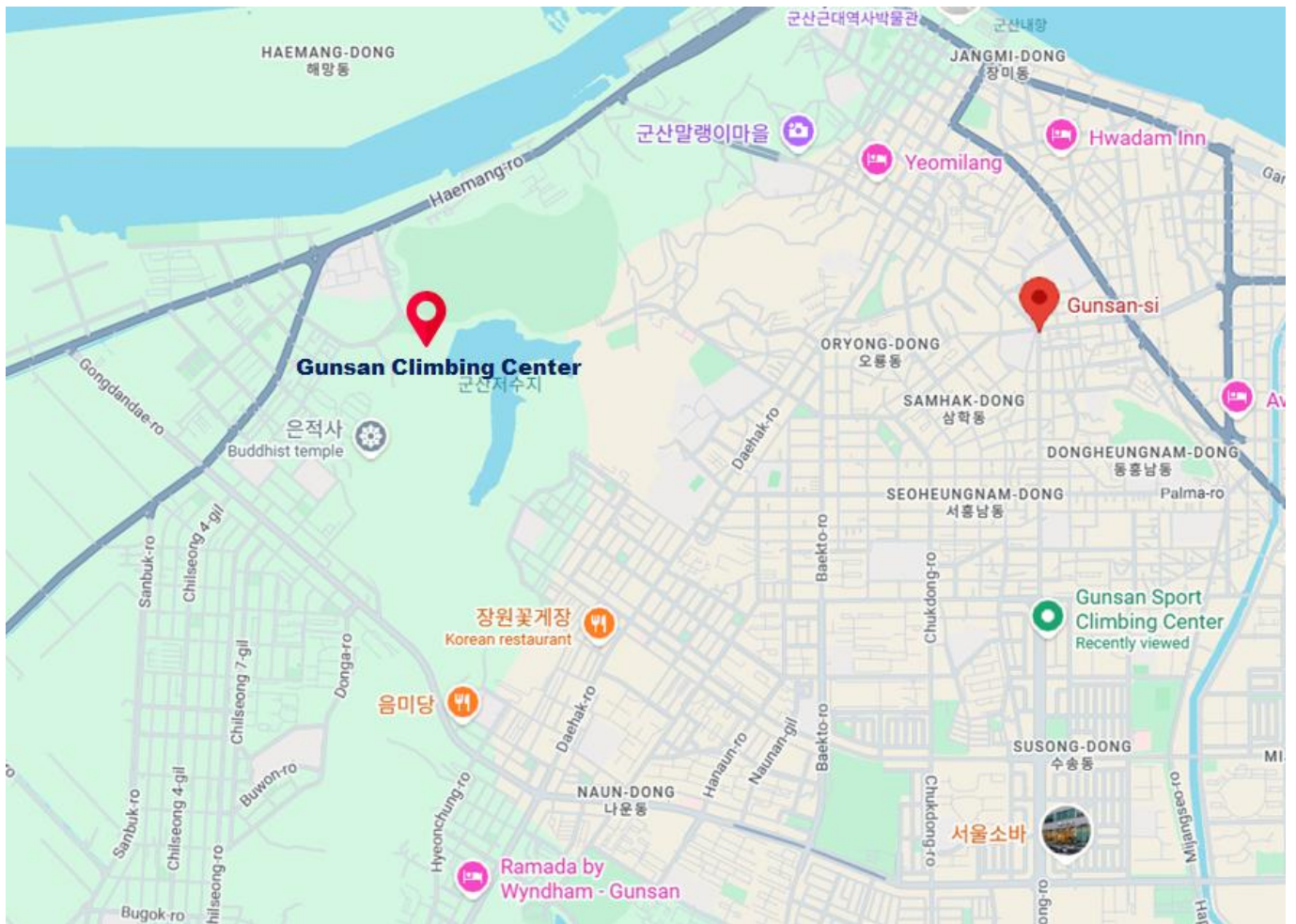

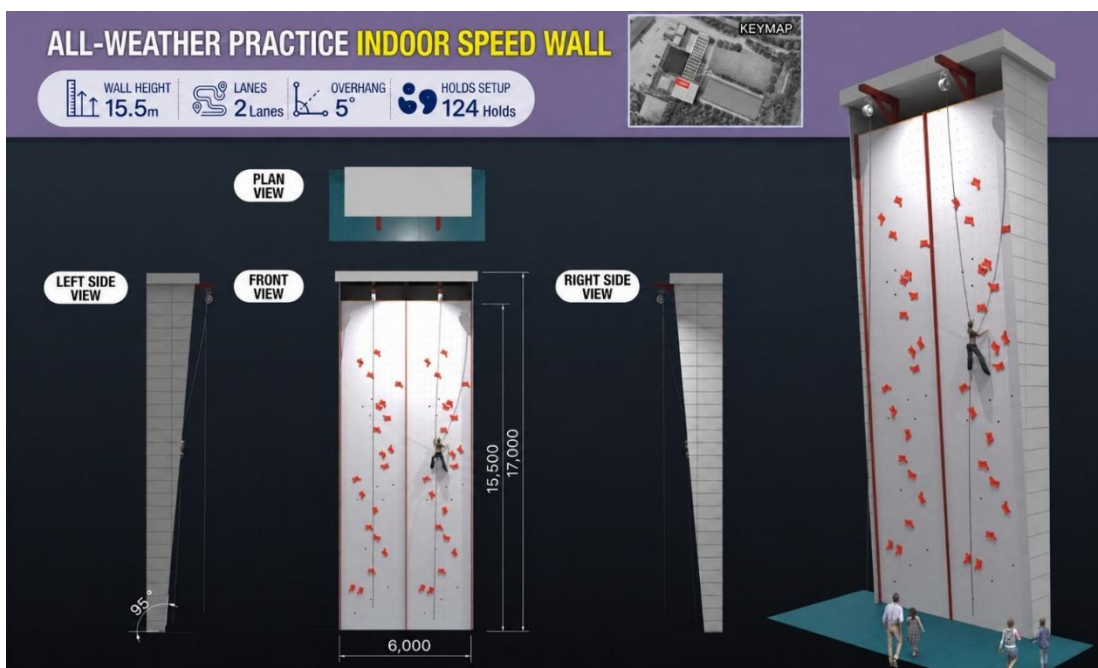
● **New Construction: Outdoor Lead Wall**

5. Event Regulations

5.1. GENERAL

World Climbing Asia Series Gunsan shall include categories:

1. for the disciplines of Boulder and Speed
2. for both Male and Female competitors; and
3. for the following age groups;

Only competitors who are or will be at least 17 years of age in the year of the competition shall be eligible to compete.

5.2. FORMAT

AC Boulder	Quota	Corresponding Format

Semi-final	24	WC Boulder Semi-final
Final	8	WC Boulder Final

If less than 36 competitors are registered after the registration deadline in the Boulder discipline, this category shall be organised with only two (2) rounds, a Qualification and Final. The fixed quota for the final round shall remain unchanged.

5.3. FEES

Registration fees shall be paid upon Confirmation of Attendance by **Cash**:

6.3. Transport

Free shuttle:

A dedicated shuttle service from Incheon / Gimpo International Airport to Gunsan is planned for participating teams. The shuttle schedule and operating details will be announced at a later date.

An official shuttle service will be provided between the official hotels and the competition venue throughout the event period. The shuttle schedule will be announced separately in the Technical Meeting.

By bus:**From Incheon International Airport (ICN)**

Direct buses operate from Incheon International Airport Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 to Gunsan Intercity Bus Terminal.

- Travel Time: Approximately 2 hours 40 minutes–3 hours
- Frequency: Multiple departures throughout the day
- Arrival: Gunsan Intercity Bus Terminal
- Event Venue: Approximately 15 minutes by car

From Gimpo International Airport (GMP)

There is no direct intercity bus from Gimpo Airport to Gunsan.

Passengers should first travel to Seoul Express Bus Terminal (Central City Terminal) and then take an express bus to Gunsan.

- Travel Time (Seoul → Gunsan): Approximately 3 hours
- Frequency: About every 20–30 minutes throughout the day.

By plane:

There are no scheduled domestic flights connecting Incheon International Airport or Gimpo International Airport directly with Gunsan Airport. Although Gunsan Airport operates domestic services, it currently serves Jeju (CJU) only.

Participants arriving by air would need to transfer via Jeju, which is not recommended for travel to Gunsan due to the longer travel time and additional flight connection.

By train:**From Incheon International Airport**

1. Take the AREX (Airport Railroad Express) to Seoul Station, or an airport limousine bus to Gwangmyeong Station.
2. Take a KTX to Iksan Station.
3. Transfer to a local train (Mugunghwa/Saemaul) or local bus to Gunsan Station.

From Gimpo International Airport

1. Travel to Seoul Station.
2. Take a KTX to Iksan Station.
3. Transfer to a local train or bus to Gunsan Station.
 - Total Travel Time: Approximately 3.5–4.5 hours

- Gunsan Station → Event Venue: Approximately 15 minutes by car.

6.4. Travel information

Participants can travel within Gunsan by city bus or taxi. Public transportation provides convenient access to the competition venue, hotels, Gunsan Station, and the Intercity Bus Terminal.

City Bus

Gunsan operates an extensive city bus network serving major areas throughout the city.

- Cash and transportation cards (T-money, etc.) are accepted.
- Route information and real-time bus arrival information are available through the major navigation applications.
- Participants are encouraged to use Naver Map or KakaoMap for English route guidance and real-time public transportation information.

Taxi

Taxis are readily available throughout Gunsan and can be hailed on the street or booked through taxi applications.

The current standard taxi fare (effective from 1 August 2023) is:

- Base fare: KRW 4,300 (first 2 km)
- Additional fare:
 - KRW 100 per 134 m, or
 - KRW 100 per 32 seconds when travelling below 15 km/h
- Late-night surcharge (00:00–04:00): 20%

6.5. Accreditations

Teams will be provided with their accreditation. Team Managers are requested to collect the badges for their entire team and distribute them accordingly.

6.6. Tickets

Entrance to all competitions (Qualification and Finals) will be free of charge. No tickets are needed.

Emergency local doctor during the event: The medical team will be on-site from the opening of the isolation zone until the end of the final competition. In addition to the emergency doctor, there will be a team of paramedics at the venue during the competition.
