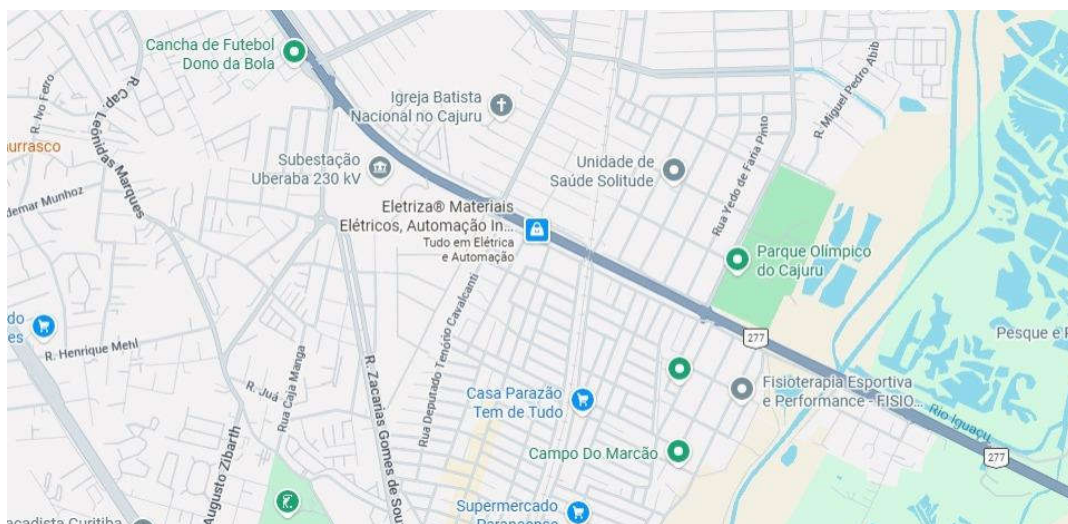

## 3. Deadlines and quotas

### 3.1. Registration deadline

The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the “Registration Date”) on August 6th at 11:59 PM UTC+0. Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

### 3.2. Quotas

Each country can register a limited number of athletes, team and medical officials. The maximum quota for each country is listed below.

**Athletes** – 5 per gender

**Head Coach** – 1

**Coaches** – 2

**Medical** – 2

### 3.3. Valid athletes' international licence

**Licences:** Only competitors and team officials with a valid World Climbing International licence are allowed to register for the competition.

### 4.2. Transport

It is strongly advised that teams prioritize to use app transport services (Uber and 99) to get to and from the venue. The area has a good coverage of those services and the fares to and from city center varies from R\$30/R\$50 (around \$6/\$10), depending on the demand. The venue is distant approximately 25/40 minutes from city center, depending on traffic, and is not easy to get by public transportation.

### 4.3. Travel information

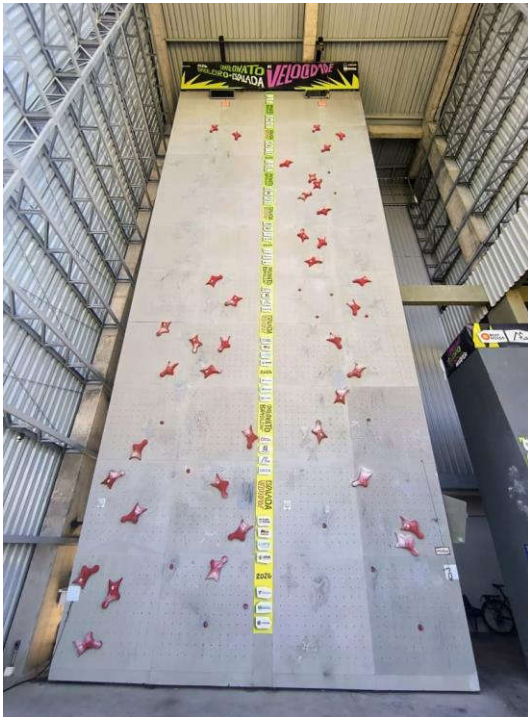
By Plane:

The airport serving Curitiba is Afonso Pena International Airport (CWB), located in São José dos Pinhais, 18km from the center of the capital of Paraná. There are direct flights from the main capitals of the southeast of Brazil, such as São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro and Belo Horizonte, as well as from Brasília and Porto Alegre. Leaving the airport is easy by taxi or Uber/99.

## 5. Sport Information

### 5.1. Venue information

The venue is the same location as the Technical Meeting and Confirmation of attendance. The Speed Wall is NOT homologated for World Record but follows all the standards of an official Speed Wall regarding holds (Voix Holds 2025), Autobelay, Timing System, and texturized wall panels.



## 5.2. Warm-up zone

The warm-up zone will be set up in the indoor area of the gym. Will be provided a warm-up speed wall with an entire lane divided in 3 sections (start,middle and finish). Also will be available a boulder wall, spray wall, boxes, and fitness equipment such as dumbbells and boxes.

## 5.1. Training Possibilities

During the week previous to the event the venue climbing wall will be made available for training of the registered teams subject to an appointment registration. More information about this will be updated in the next weeks.
