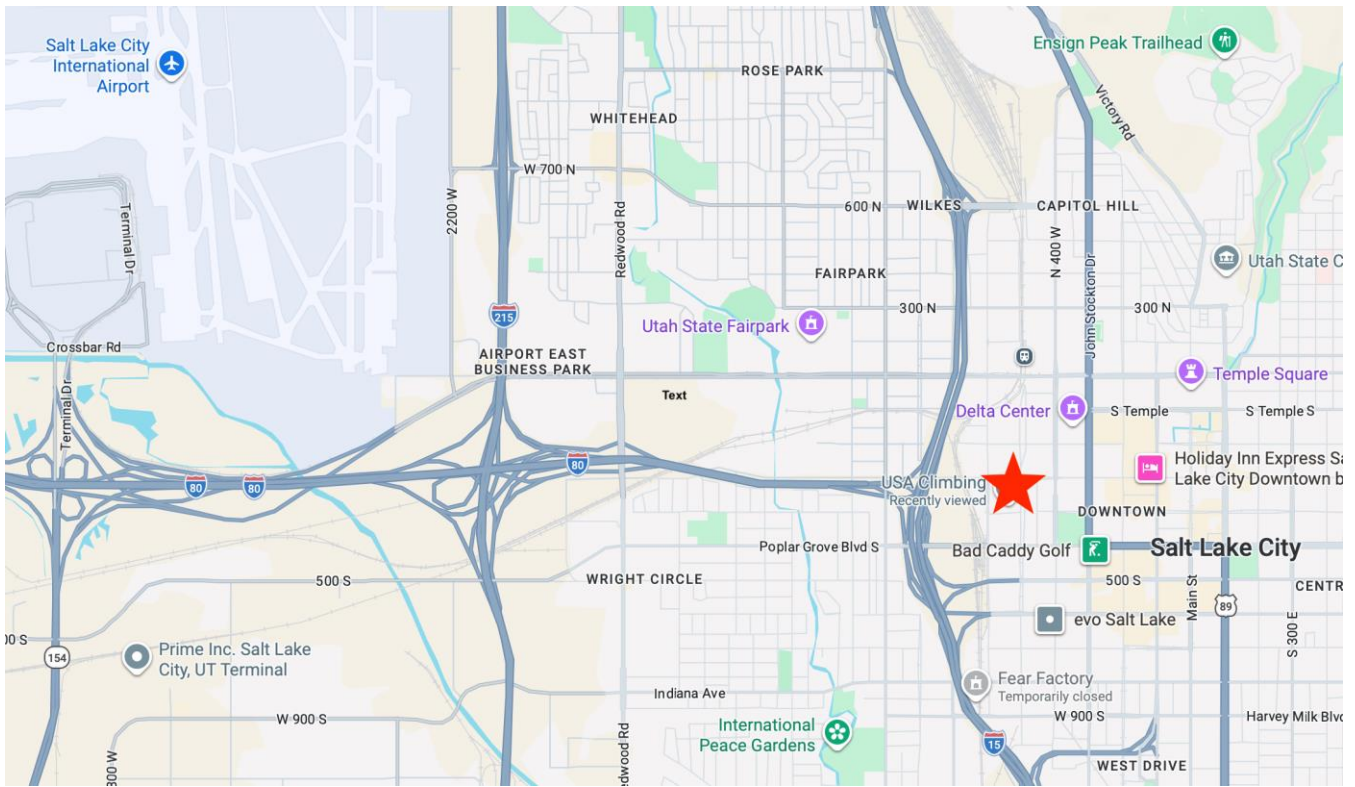

The confirmation of attendance for Boulder, Lead, and Speed will occur on the same day. The event accreditation for registered team members can be picked up on any day when the accreditation is available. With your accreditation badge, you have access to the spectator area for the duration of the event. Accreditation opening hours will be discussed and shared in the Technical Meeting.

You will still need to confirm your attendance, either in person during the above-mentioned registration time or via message to the Event Director.

Registration for the World Climbing Pan America Series Salt Lake City 2026 (*Boulder, Lead, & Speed*) event will tentatively open on the USA Climbing Result Service **Wednesday, May 6, 2026**. The registration fee will increase at midnight (*UTC*) at the end of **Tuesday, July 7, 2026, in UTC**. The deadline for registration is **10 days prior to the first day of competition on Tuesday, July 14, 2026 at 23:59 UTC**.

Due to the timing of the program, there will be a maximum athlete registration quote for all disciplines by gender. Both the Boulder and Lead disciplines will have a maximum allocation for 100 registered athletes (*per gender*), while the Speed discipline will have a maximum allocation for 50 registered athletes (*per gender*).

U.S. Citizens wishing to compete must be aged 17 or over in the year of competition (2026) and must have a current USA Climbing Youth & Elite Series Membership. Those aged 18 and over must also have current Safesport Training completed.



Non-U.S. Citizens wishing to compete must be aged 17 or over in the year of competition (2026), must be representing a Pan American Federation/country, and must have either a current USA Climbing International Membership (*free with proof of membership and good standing in current federation*). When applying for a USA Climbing International Membership, proof of membership status with the athlete's Pan American Federation must be submitted to [info@usaclimbing.org](mailto:info@usaclimbing.org).

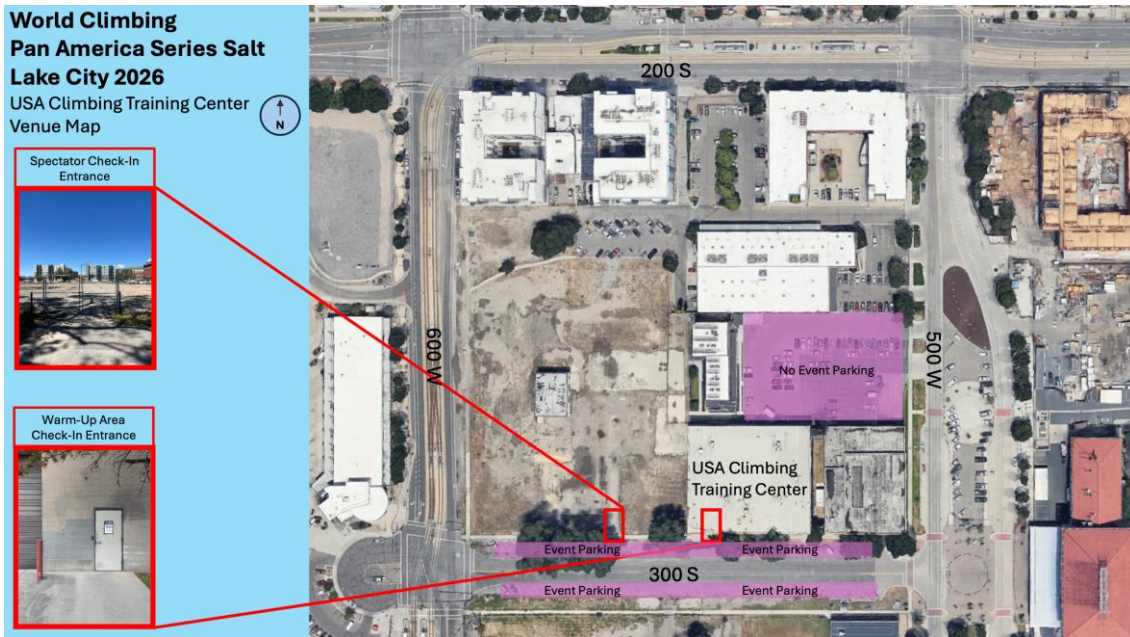
### 3.2. Valid athletes' international licence

**Licences:** Only competitors and team officials with a valid World Climbing International licence in representation of a Pan American Federation are allowed to register for the competition.

**In addition to registering within the USA Climbing Results Service, each federation with participating athletes and officials, must register those participants within the World Climbing Results Service (ATTENTION: 2 REGISTRATIONS!). For USA Climbing athletes and officials who do not have a World Climbing license, USA Climbing will register those participants within the World Climbing Results Service along with those who already have a World Climbing license.**

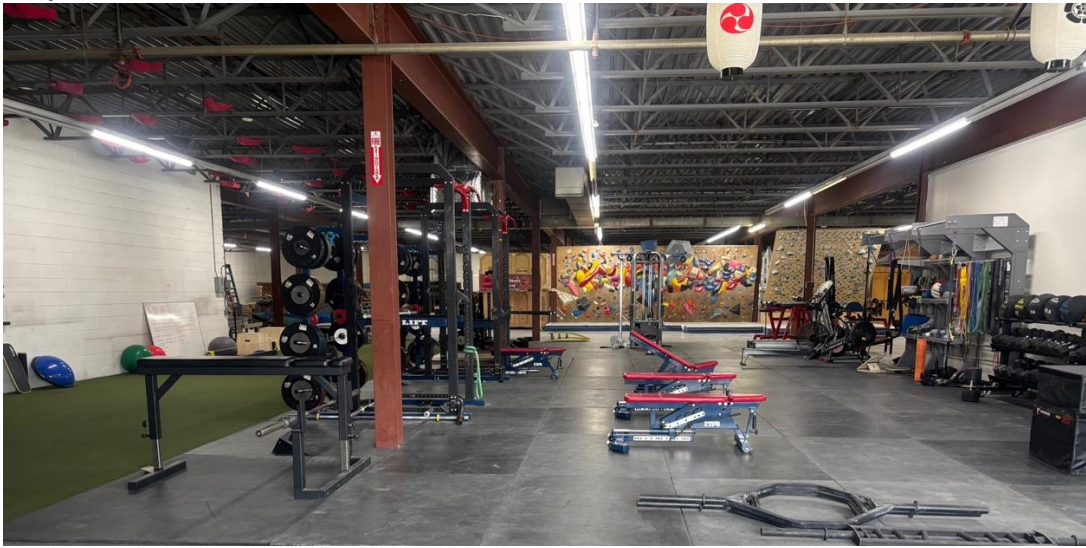
4.2. Warm-up zone

Boulder and Lead athletes will have access to upstairs (*Hangboards and campus boards, spray wall, boulder terrain*), while Speed athletes will have access to downstairs (*Walltopia Quantum Board, indoor speed wall sections, indoor top rope & boulder spray wall terrain, strength & conditioning area*).

### Scheduling Visa Appointments:

If an applicant is not able to schedule a visa appointment before their date of travel, they can request an expedited appointment. To request an expedite, the applicant must first schedule a regular appointment (even if it is beyond the date of travel), and then re-enter the scheduling system and select the "Request Expedite/Emergency Appointment" option;

When requesting an expedite, applicants must clearly explain their reason for travel and dates of travel to the U.S; Applicants can also consider applying in a third-country location with shorter wait-times. There is no penalty for applying anywhere appointments are available, even outside one's home country.

##### **By Plane: Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) - approximately 6 mi | 9.5 km**

The Salt Lake City International Airport is approximately 8-minutes by car to the competition venue. Taxi/Uber/Lyft will be available from the airport into Salt Lake City, UT. The UTA [TRAX Green line](#) can also be taken from *Airport Station* to *Arena Station*.
