2.2. Technical Meeting

Location: Official Hotel

IMPORTANT: Please note that a maximum of two (2) National Team Officials per Country will be allowed to access the Technical Meeting.

2.3. Confirmation of Participation

Location: Same location as Technical Meeting

Confirmation of participation is mandatory for each discipline and must be done in person by the Head of Delegation. In case a National Team did not register the Head of Delegation, another member of the National Team shall be appointed to confirm attendance of the Team. **In case of emergencies and exceptional late arrival (e.g., flight delay), the Event Delegate must be informed immediately.** Failure to provide this information in a timely manner may result in the athletes not being permitted to compete. A digital copy of the athletes' passports shall be provided at the confirmation of attendance.

3. Deadlines and quotas

3.1. Registration deadline

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 7 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **27 August 2026 at 11:59 PM UTC+0**. Following the Registration Date and until 5 days before the first day of competition, Member Federations may, in exceptional circumstances, withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members to replace those withdrawn, provided that any substitute competitors must be registered in the same Category as the withdrawn competitor.

3.2. Valid athletes' international licence

Licences: Only competitors and team officials with a valid World Climbing International licence and approved medical status are allowed to register for the competition.

3.3. Quotas:

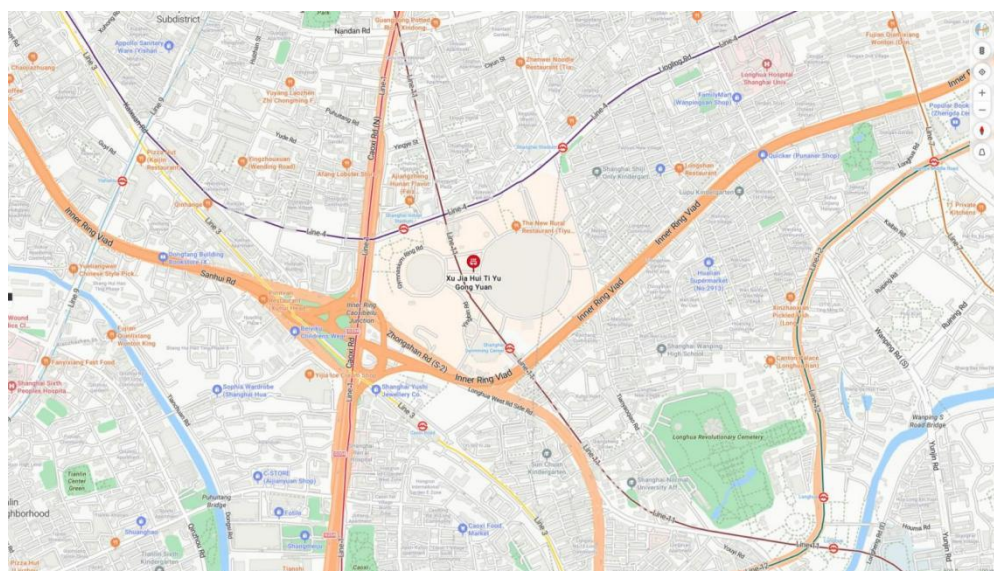
- Each team could register 4 male athletes and 4 female athletes maximum
- Host team could register 6 male athletes and 6 female athletes maximum
- Athletes are encouraged to compete in Speed Relay and Speed Mixed Relay
- Each team may register up to 1 team leader, 2 coaches, and 1 medical staff.

5.2. Accommodation

Top 10 teams will receive free accommodation including meals and rooms from 3rd – 6th September for a maximum of 4 athletes (2 male&2female) and 1 team official. Free accommodation will be provided for the two highest World Ranking athletes for each gender of the National Team; the arrangement of the accommodations are:

- Twin-bed rooms (shared occupancy).
- Buffet meals.
- All other participants are responsible for their own expenses.

5.3. Transport

The Organizing Committee will arrange or reimburse flight tickets with a cap of USD 1,000 per athlete for the top 2 male and top 2 female registered athletes from the Top 10 teams. Eligibility is determined based on the World Rankings as of 23:59 UTC+0, 27 August 2026. Reimbursement will be processed according to actual travel expenses if less than USD 1,000.

The Organizing Committee will provide free airport/train station transfers between the following airports/train station and the official hotel for all teams. Free shuttle services between the official hotel and the competition venue will also be provided.

⑩ **Shanghai Pudong International Airport (PVG)**

Approx. 55 km from the official hotel (about 1 hour by car)

⑩ **Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport (SHA)**

Approx. 15 km from the official hotel (about 30 minutes by car)
